BEGINNINGS OF MODERN DAIRYING
RECALLED BY MEMORIST

ANNIVERSARY

Dairying is one of the oldest industries known to civilized man. The history of modern dairying, which is built on the cleanliness and purity of milk, is only fifty years old. It was in 1857 that Gail Borden, inventor of the process for condensing milk in a vacuum, established his first company. To operate his process successfully he found that pure milk was an absolute necessity, and the rules that he formulated for safeguarding the quality of milk have become the basis of public health regulations in Canada and the United States.

The story of the progress made by the dairy industry in the past thirty years should be of interest to everyone. The Board of Associated Dairy Farmers has been pleased not only in improving the quality of the milk sold to the public but also in developing new uses for milk and new products in which milk is used. They have thus helped to enlarge the farmer's market to the point that in the Province of Ontario dairy products now account for more than a quarter of the annual agricultural revenue.

In the series of Bureau advertisements now appearing in the Georgetown Herald, the story of the milk industry is told. In using the name paper advertising to tell their story to the public the companies give another proof of the modern and progressive spirit that has ever been characteristic of their policies.
