cation have offered to provide half the cost of building and also of equipping these class-rooms.

Any high school district not supplying the above are required to pay for such instruction in another school, and also to provide the transportation for those wishing to take these two additional subjects.

Our staff has been qualifying to undertake this new work. The division of the costs of such addition to our school is as follows:
The Department of Education \$7,500.00
The County 13,000.00
The Town 25,000.00

We are practically compelled to make this addition to our school at this time to be in accord with the requirements. With this addition we may expect increased attendance of from twenty to thirty per cent. and our requirements would be amply met in our present plans for years to come.

The Government yearly grant would be increased nearly seven hundred dollars. It now amounts to about thirteen hundred.

We could use now to great advantage in our school work, all our plans call for. We trust you will give our proposals the favorable consideration they deserve.
