ICE CREAM IN FESTIVE DRESS
No need to worry about the dessert problem for the holiday festivities.

For the holiday season many of the manufacturers make ice cream specialties suitable for the occasion.

1 quart brick ice cream
Layer of sponge cake 1 inch thick
4 egg whites

Ice Cream Puff with Chocolate Sauce
Split cream puffs in two. Fill with vanilla ice cream.

Cream Puffs
1/2 cup butter
1 cup bread flour
1 cup boiling water

Add butter to boiling water. When melted add flour all at once. Stir over the heat until mixture leaves the sides of saucepan.

Chocolate Sauce
3 ounces (squares) unsweetened chocolate
1 cup cold water
3 cups sugar

Meringues Glacées with Ice Cream
Shape ice cream into ovals with tablespoon and place between two meringue shells.

Meringues Glacées
4 egg whites
1 1/2 teaspoons vanilla
1 1/2 cups fruit or fine granulated sugar

HEROIC CHINESE BOY SCOUTS

Details of the heroic work done by Chinese Boy Scouts at Shanghai and elsewhere in China have been hinted at in press despatches and news reels.

Despite the grave danger of bombing in and around Shanghai, Chinese Boy Scouts carried out their Scout obligation to "help other people at all times."

Immediately after high explosives had been dropped on Shanghai, young Scouts began searching for the dead, dressing the slightly injured with bandages improvised from blood-soaked rags of material, and acting as stretcher bearers.

One of the young boys performed a task from which many a grown man would have shrunk. A lift in a building had been halted between the ground and first floors as the explosion cut off power.

Simultaneously, bombing was going on in Chongchiao in the Jussfield district, and many civilians were killed.

Boy Scouts, together with Civil Guards, are also helping in refugee camps, and attending the wounded cases in emergency hospitals.

Officers of the French Commission Service Shanghai Sound Scouts are bravely useful, while still other Scouts were called upon to help look after the crowds of frightened refugee children.

County Plan Forests
Bruce County will start reforestation of a 1,000-acre tract in Amabel Township south of Warton.

A county forest for Grey was suggested to the County Council in the special report of the "Restoration Committee."

Nearly 800,000 trees were planted this year under the Bruce County reforestation scheme which is sponsored by the county council.

Seed Grain Suggestions for Spring of 1938

The Ontario Department of Agriculture has just completed a careful survey of the seed situation for the spring seeding of 1938.

With this in view the Department feels that if Ontario farmers follow out some such policy there will be no great shortage of seed next spring.

Many farmers have a fanning mill of some description, which with a little repair and an extra screen or two will clean grain.

What is more important is that the farmers start now so that the cleaning and germinating can be done properly and not leave it until a spring rush develops.

To make a germination test in your home, put a piece of blotting paper on a plate with just enough water to keep it damp.

Should you desire to have this germination test made by the Dominion Seed Department, then it will be necessary to send a one-pound sample of your seed properly labelled.

Winter Breeding of Chickens
The poultryman with proper equipment can handle chicks in mid-winter with as little mortality as with April chicks.

Even the hatchability of eggs are higher priced to start with. Then it will take more fuel than with spring brooding.

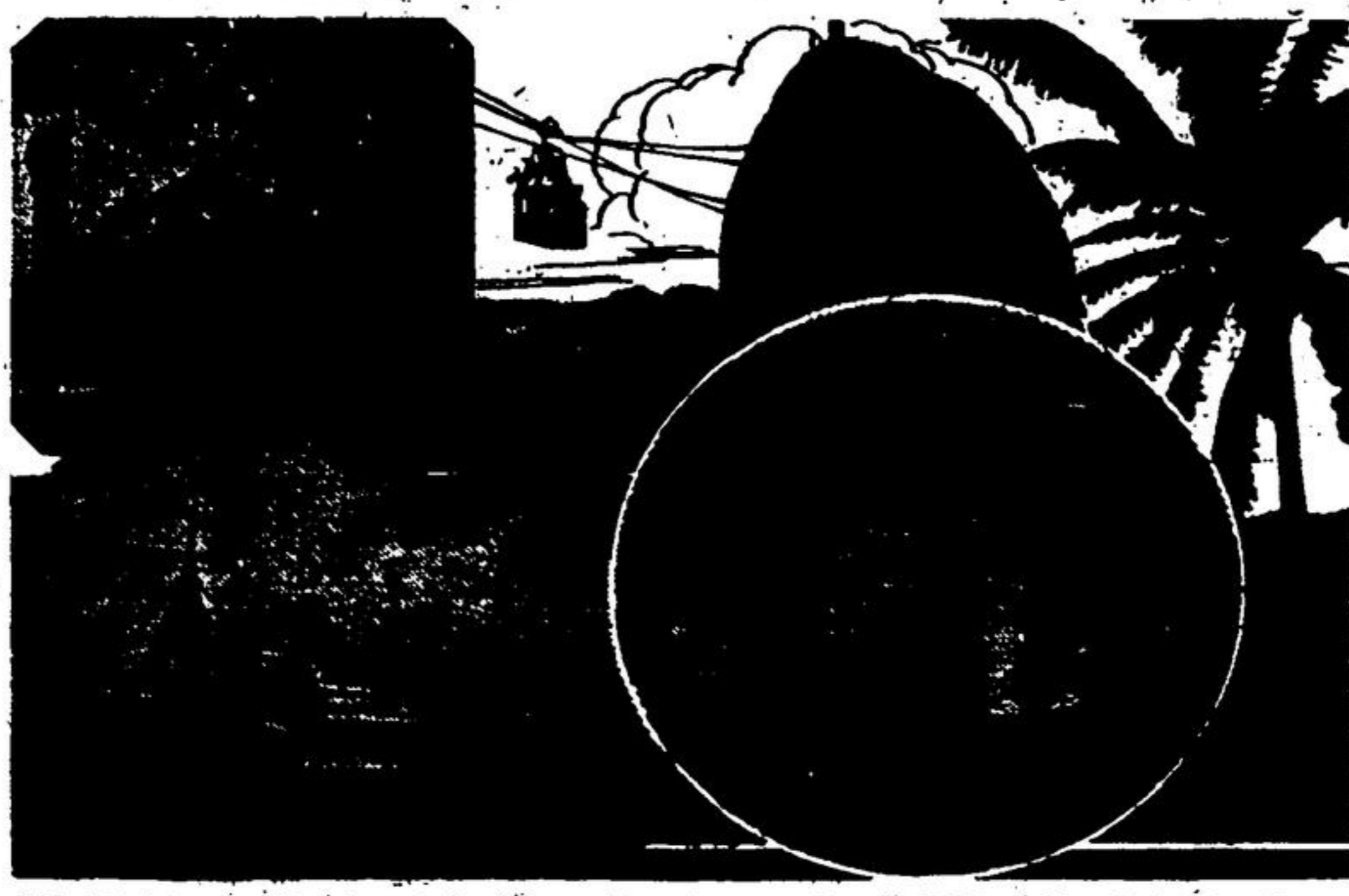
Brothers will catch a high market and pullets should be laying early in the fall or even in late summer when egg prices are at their peak.

Brotherhood houses un-entitled for prolonged zero weather and the higher prices for chicks will build the number going in for January chicks.

Nevertheless there should be good returns for the few who do, and they can prolong the use of their equipment as those who have January chicks usually have another pullet coming into production at different seasons.

January chicks will go on to range early in the season, or they may be raised indoors until ready for the laying pen.
