Between Fighting Fish Blamete fighting fish have red fine. which they wave at friend or enemy. If they ever had a friend. These fish ere known to the trade as Retta Chimbogdts and in Hlam they are trained to battle to the minure of rock fighting. Natives of Hism are fond of Betta t'ambogdia battica.

They take two males and put them in separate bowls of water. Then they bring out a bowl full of females. placing it between the two combatants. The males stare rather recentfully at each other for a bit. Then they gradually start getting nasty. They begin churning up the water, waving their red fine and tooking daggers at each other. Finally, when their wrath reaches the stage that they've either got to fight or explode, they are tossed into the same tank.

From then on the action is fast. The Betta Cambogdia take their fighting sectionaly and there are no reat periods nor long counts. They fight until one or the other is dead.

Big Heles From Little Hara In the Elighth century, or therebonts, when the Vikings desired to summon a reancil or a body of soldiers they did so with the use of a horn of peculiar construction, and two of these have been recently sent to this country for exhibition purposes in a museum. The instrument consists of a long curled tobe gradually expanding into a flare which recembles somewhat a modern loud speaker.
