EGG WEIGHTS  
The attention of egg shippers and  
egg packers is called by the Dominion  
Department of Agriculture to the fact  
that in the revised Standard egg  
grades, individual eggs serve as the  
basis of weight. These weights must  
be in the revised Standard egg  
grades. In the instance of Grade  
"A" large, for example, each individual  
egg must weigh at least 56 grams  
two ounces and over. Similarly in  
the medium pack each individual egg  
must weigh at least 43 ounces  
and under 54 to the dozen.
