### News and Information For the Busy Farmer

#### International Flowering Match

The Women's International Flowering Match and "Pansy" contest, sponsored by the property of Mr. Frank C. O'Connor, York County, Ontario, will be held in the City of Toronto, October 9, 10, 11 and 12.

#### Sheep Killing Costs

The damage done by straggling dogs to sheep flocks in Old Ontario has been estimated by R. W. Wade, Provincial Live Stock Commissioner, as at least \$30,000. This is the amount of money which municipalities throughout the province have had to pay out in compensation for sheep killed. Provincial and municipal regulations prevent all farmers whose flocks have been ravaged to apply for compensation and settlement is made by municipal authority.

#### Drive on Warble Fly Planned in Ontario

All over Ontario farmers are taking steps to eliminate the Warble Fly, report officials of the Canadian Co-operative Wool Growers who are working with groups of live stock men in an effort to check this pest, which is responsible for a loss of \$10,000,000 dollars in live stock and probably five times as much in regarding milk and beef production.

#### Why Do Birds Migrate?

What makes birds go south in the autumn and north in the spring? Dr. William Howard, Professor of Zoology at the University of Alberta, believes it is certain internal organs which are affected by sunlight. In spring the lengthening days and increased sunlight inspires the northward movement and in autumn the reverse. To test his theory, Prof. Howard turned loose several hundred crows at Medicine Hat and will attempt to trace their movements over Alberta and Saskatchewan. One group were just ordinary crows which were kept in cages under ordinary conditions, the other group also were ordinary crows except that they had been fed with artificial light during the winter season over a number of months.
