### BURIAL PLACE OF DRAKE AND HAWKINS

Probably many of those who travel through the waters of the Caribbean Sea on the morning hours of the Canadian National steamship fleet in the British West Indies service little realize that as their ship plows through these waters they are passing over the burial place of two of England's greatest admirals who laid the foundations of the greatness of the British Navy, namely, Sir Francis Drake and Sir John Hawkins. It was off Nombre de Dios, in the Spanish Main, that the remains of Drake were committed to the deep on January 29, 1595, being preceded by his kinsman and trusted friend, Sir John Hawkins, who accompanied him and who died off the island of Porto Rico, his body being buried in the waters close by. Two of the liners bear these illustrious names, the "Lady Drake" and the "Lady Hawkins."
