Postpaid Cattle Fair

The annual postpaid cattle fair, held at Oshawa on Tuesday, April 10th, brought a top price for the best cow and calf pair for bulls, the normal average being \$200 for cows and heifers and \$1100 for a head and calf. The top cow and calf pair was sold for \$1100 each, while only fifteen other pairs were sold for over \$1000 each. The event was attended by close to five hundred people, drawn from the best breeding areas of Western Ontario.

Wholesale Egg Market

The satisfactory out-turn of last year's egg production and the development of the export trade during the past year are factors which will lead to a steady and increasing egg market during the coming spring. Another factor which, perhaps, has not been given sufficient attention is that the demand for eggs for the manufacture of frozen eggs is much more active this spring than a year ago. At this time last year, stocks of frozen eggs in Canada were fully twice as large as they are now. Operations during last spring were not very extensive.

Care of the New Pig
