**99 Magistrates Dismissed**

ONTARIO DIVIDED INTO 16 MAGISTERIAL DISTRICTS WITH 46 JUDGES

The number of magistrates in the province is cut from 147 to 99 by the decision of Hon. Arthur W. Hanes, attorney-general and justice of the peace, on the Ontario government. The province, under the new plan, is distributed into 16 magisterial districts. They will be permitted to carry on any other business. Under the new scheme the courts will be uniformly of one class, so that they will not be limited to carry on any other business. One of the magistrates in each district will be designated senior magistrate and shall have the right to preside at the sessions of the court. The new scheme will be operative on September 1st.
