Remembrance Day Public Holiday .

Remembrance Day, November 11 will be legally observed as a public holiday, and to assure its observance the House of Commons on Wednesday of last week passed a bill, sponsored by Minister of Justice Guthrie, which included the definition of Rememrance Day in the general interpretation along with other public holidays. In 1931 a separate act was passed making Remembrance Day a holiday. The bill places Remembrance Day under the public holidays listed in the Interpretation Act, which must be observed.
