### APPLE BLOSSOM FESTIVAL

In the Annapolis Valley in Nova Scotia, the British Empire's largest apple belt, Apple Blossom Festival will be held this year from May 31st to June 3rd with pageants, parades, music and sports.

Each year the land of Evangeline is an enchanted valley of pink and white blossoms, orchards stretching for miles and miles, their fragrance and beauty. For the last two years all the residents have celebrated the opening of the blossom festival with their promise of a future harvest because this is the birthplace of apple trees in America, the first apple tree having been planted there from Normandy by Pierre Marquet in 1604.

The celebration this year will be on King's Jubilee. Opening on Friday evening, May 31st, the festival will be held at Cardiff, Wales, late in October.
