### MALACHI FORTELLS A NEW DAY

International Uniform Sunday School Lesson, December 22, 1933

**GOLDEN TEXT:** "Abold, I will be a man of God, and I will prepare the way before me." Malachi 3: 1.

**LESSON PASSAGE:** Malachi 3: 1-12.

The book of Malachi is the only one of the prophets and we can only surmise how he was used to utterance by the channel of his spirit, and intermingling with foreign words prevalent in his day. ### HYDRO OPERATION IN GEORGETOWN

Georgetown's total of Hydro power and surplus is now \$1,140,000. The reserve for equity in the Hydro system is \$1,140,000, and there are now \$1,140,000 in Hydro power. Georgetown's total of \$1,140,000 contains a growth from \$200,000 in 1914; however, used in 1933 according to the latest statistics was \$1,140,000 as contrasted with \$118 in 1914. Total revenue last year was \$1,140,000 as against \$19,251 in 1914; domestic and commercial revenue last year was \$2,200,000 as compared with \$220,000 in 1914; kilowatt hours sold for lighting was \$2,200,000 as compared with \$220,000 in 1914; kilowatt hours sold for power was \$2,200,000 as compared with \$220,000 in 1914. The rate is much less than half the average rate prevailing in even larger United States cities.
