Canadian Fish Loaf-Take two cups of Canadian fish—"left-overs" if desired-or a pound tin of canned fish. fishe the fish, and add to it two cups of fine, soft bread crumbs, two beaten eggs, three-quarters of a cup of milk salt and pepper to suit the taste, a tablespoon of onion juice (or a finely minced onion) and a teaspoon of lemon juice. After mixing the inware Ave., Toronto, formerly of Es- gredients well, place them in a greased pan, dot with butter, and bake in a moderate oven (350 degrees P.) for three-quarters of an hour or until the loaf is firm and browned. .

Any kind of Canadian fish may be used in making this loaf. If canned fish is used, the oil from the tin should be poured in with the other ingredients and the bones crushed and left with the fish. The bones of fish contain calcium and the oil contains vitamins. Creamed peas or tomato sauce may be served with fish oaf, as well as baked potatoes.
