hood by earnest prayer. Misunderstood, 12-16. A consecrated woman befriended a family which was under a social ban and was severely criticised for showing interest and good will to those who bore the stigma but were in all-the greater need of help. She was challenged and gossiped about but she kept right on obeying her own conscience seeking to follow her Master in calling sinners to repentance and reformation. It takes grace to meet situations like that. While Hannah prayed in her great agony of tears Eli thought that she was under the influence of alcohol. Her emotion was so great that words failed her and the aged priest reproached her. She replied that her emotion was due to sorrow not to intoxication. With dignity she defended herself and showed that she had a more acute problem than drink. Her very faith in the love of God was at stake. Her life's mission seemed to be in jeopardy. Was it any wonder that she prayed not with conventional propricty, but with the uttermost abandon of a soul facing defeat and despair?
