OBITUARY

N. F. LINDSAY

Ninian Flockhart Lindsay, for many years resident of the Township of Esqueving, adjoining Acton, passed away in his 83rd year, on Wednesday, November 30th, at St. Joseph's Hospital, Guelph, after an illness of two months.

Ninian F. Lindsay was the son of the late Ninian Lindsay and Mary Rutherford. He was born on the homestead, where his only brother, James R. Lindsay resided until his death, two years ago, and for about fifty years had resided on the farm just east of Acton, on No. 7 Highway. A sister, Barbara, passed away many years ago, and the only remaining member of the family is Miss Christina L. Lindsay of Georgetown.

Ninian F. Lindsay married Jane Alice Graham, of Ashgrove. He was blessed with a family of five, all of whom remain to revere the memory of a loving father, namely: Mae A., who was constantly with her father during his declining years; Ninian G., on the homestead; Jean C. and Anna A., dental nurses in Toronto, and Dr. James C., dentist also of Toronto. Dr. Lindsay was trustworthy and a man of outstanding character and in his quiet manner was always ready to help those in trouble. He was a member of the Trustee Board of the Methodist Church, Acton, later becoming the United Church, for many years he was a member of the Board of Directors of the Halton Union Fire Insurance Co., and President during that time.

The funeral service from the home on Saturday was conducted by his pastor, Rev. Dr. E. M. Morrow, who referred to Mr. Lindsay's Christian character. The solo, "In the Garden of Prayer," sung by the pastor, was indeed very appropriate.

Many friends from the surrounding district and a distance, including Toronto, Guelph, Brampton, Milton, Woodbridge, Malton, Georgetown, and Erin gathered at the service on Saturday to pay tribute to a life esteemed.

The pallbearers, who were neighbors were James Mann, Thos. Kennedy, A. T. Mann, Shirley Watson, Richard Brown and A. C. Claxidge. Flower bearers were Hugh Lindsay, nephew, and Alvin McDonald, W. J. McDonald, Oliver Moffat, Joe Anthony, Mark Given, Roy Young, Donald Matheson. —Free Press.
