CANADIAN MOSAIC

Definitely ranking in its own field, with his recent book, "Steel of Empire," "Canadian Mosaic," by John Murray Gibbon, General Publicity Agent, Canadian Pacific Railway, is a notable contribution to Canadian literature and to Canadian folk lore.

The book, which contains 424 pages with 24 magnificent colored illustrations from pastels of Canadian types and landscapes by such artists as James Crookart, W. J. Phillips, R.C.A., Kathleen Shackleton, N. de Grandmison, Ernst Neuman, and R. H. Palenske; and 48 pages of photographs and paintings reproduced in half tone, also contains a number of maps which show the origin of Canada's various racial groups and their settlements in the Dominion.

The Canadian people will remember the broadcast series heard over the C.B.C. national network last winter, entitled "Canadian Mosaic," in which Mr. Gibbon traced the adaptation of Old World music to the growing traditions of Canada's various races in the new land. His "Canadian Mosaic" which appeared at the end of last month is the result of the exhaustive studies made by Mr. Gibbon in preparation of the broadcast series, and by his amplification of the information that he gathered in the course of a living and vivid picture of the contribution made to Canadian history and culture by the 25 European races from which the Dominion has drawn much of its new blood.

The scope and purpose of the book is explained in the preface: "The Canadian race of the future is being superimposed on the original native Indian races and is being made up of over thirty European racial groups, each of which has its own history, customs, and traditions. While there is still time, let us make a survey of these racial groups—see where they came from, what relationship, if any, they had with each other in Europe, what culture they enjoyed and how much of that culture they have been able to bring with them."

This Mr. Gibbon seems to have done very successfully with his usual facility of presenting worthwhile and in-

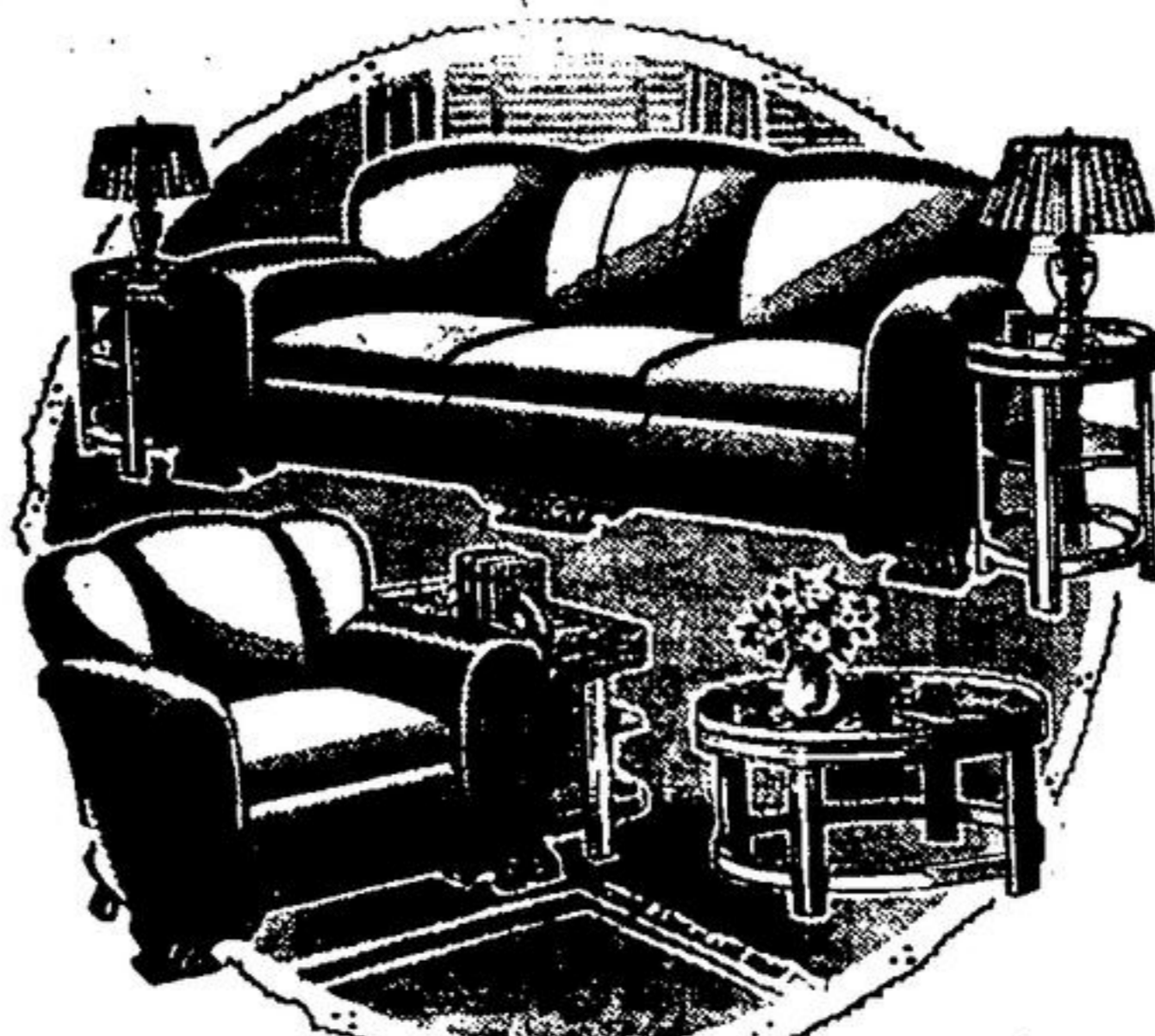

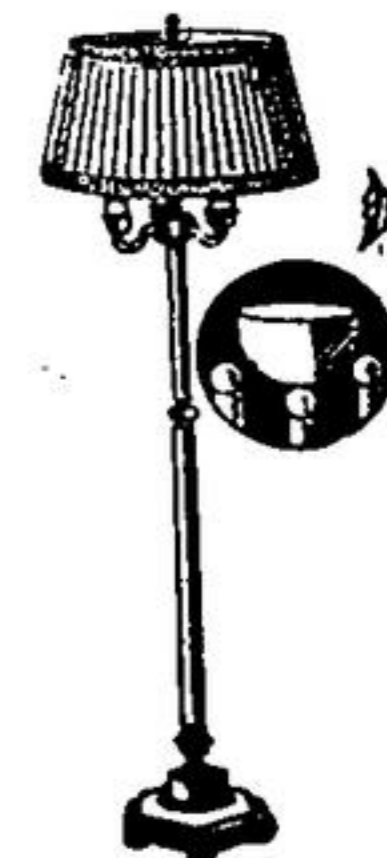

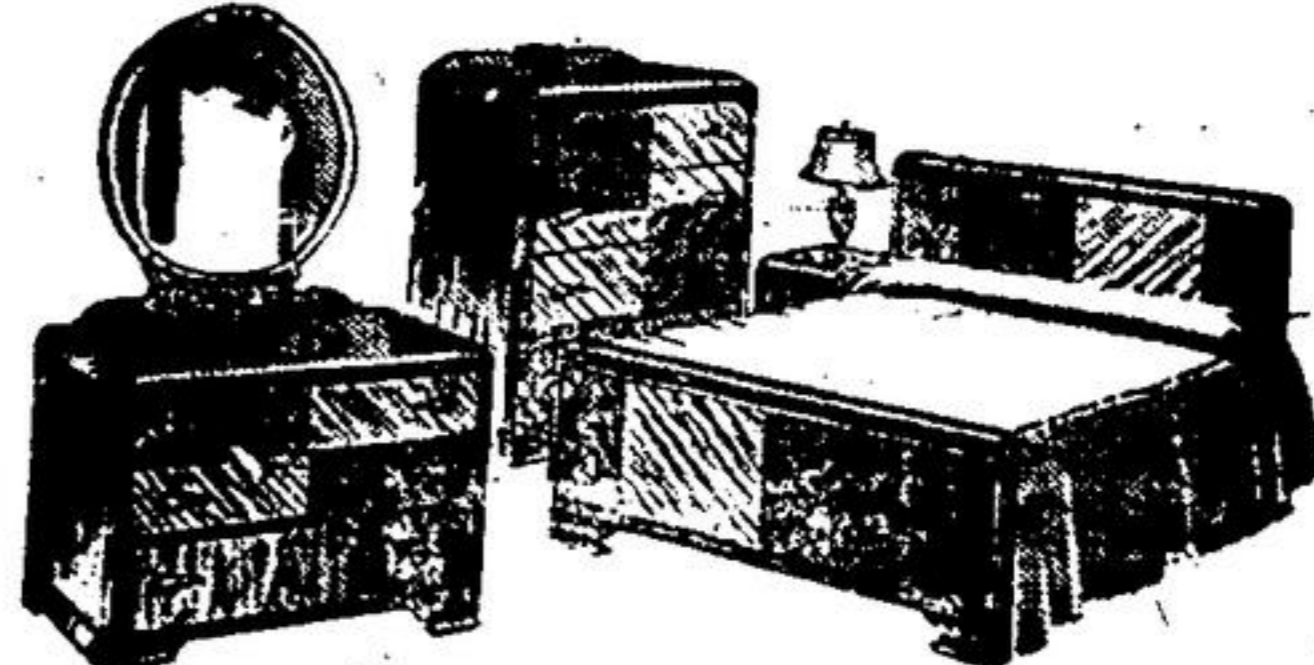
