#### Coconut Cookies Appeal to Menfolks

By Frances Lee Barton IF you are on the supper committee for the Christmas party at your church, you'll be trying to decide what your



contribution to the feast will be. May we suggest several batches of these cookies? They're good substantial cookies and the menfolks will enjoy them im-

Jumbe Coconut Cockies

2 cups shredded coconut, cut; 36. sifted cake flour; 2 teaspoons double-acting baking powder; 14 teaspoon salt; 1/2 cup butter or other shortening; 1 cup sugar; 1 egg, unbeaten.

Add 16 cup coconut to cream; let stand. Sift flour once, measure, add baking powder and salt, and sift again. Cream butter thoroughly, add sugar gradually, creaming until light and fluffy; then add ogs and beat thoroughly. Add flour, alternately with cream mixture, stirring well after each addition. Chill. Roll 14 inch thick on slightly floured board. Cut with floured \$1% inch cutter and place on ungreased baking sheet. Curinkle with remaining 114 cups coconut. Bake in hot oven (400° F.) 12 to 14 minutes. Makes 2% dozen cookies.

KEEPING TREE FRESH

If a Christmas tree is set in water when it first comes into the house and is kept in water while it is part of the Christmas decoration, it will remein fresh and green for at least a week longer. Water should be replaced as it evaporates. If the base of a Christmas tree is trimmed with a sharp knife just before it is mounted, the pores will be left open, allowing water to rise in the stem to the living cells which are still trying to provide the tree with food and motsture. Spruce and fir retain their needles longer than most other Christmas trees.
