A timely-warning has been issued by the Industrial Accident Prevention Associations of potential dangers in preparing Christmas decorations at home. Two many people, the Assoclations warn, in the rush and bustle of setting up their multi-colored Christmas lights and wreaths forget to take reasonable precautions against the unseen danger there may be behind all the glistening and glitter. Ohristmas tree lights that nave been tucked away in the cellar since last year should be carefully examined to make sure the wiring is in good condition. Exposed wires may be overlooked and cause a short circuit which may lead to setting fire to the tree. Extension cords and wires strung about the room for temporary lighting should be carefully attached to the baseboards to avoid tripping and possible injury from falls.
