In any event we can hardly see in 1939, a debacle such as was witnessed in 1929 -unless we run into a war panic the like of which neither appearement nor truculence can avert.

On the whole, our guess - which is neither better nor worse than any other person's guess-is that the coming twelve months will see business going forward slowly in a less stormy see than in the last twelve months, but that rapid progress is not likely for the reason that taxes will continue to take too large a proportion of the national income.
