> > It is known that for many years some householders have secretly connected their cesspools, etc to town storm sewers. The odour of such maternal in traps on some streets is at times overpowering and a source of complaint. From there it passes directly into the river. For some years the practice has been permitted to continue. It was felt that sewer installation would soon be undertaken and that these people were driven to these measures when all other methods had failed. Should sewer installation be further deferred, these 'hookups' will be cut off when found. Furthere, those homes whose waste disposal is unsatisfactory and where there is no means of correcting it, will be declared unfit for habitation and closed. This will create a great hardship for some. The only alternative is sewer installation.

With sewers all bathroom and laundry waste, water from eave troughs, flooding cellars are adequately cared for. The property owner will pay each year for 20 years a small sum which will aggregate less over that period of time than is now being spent for temporary methods. Further, the town will be a healthier, more prosperous, and a more pleasant place for


