PAUL PLEADS HIS OWN CASE

International Uniform Sunday School Lesson, June 4th, 1939

GOLDEN TEXT: "I have lived in all good conscience before God until this day." Acts 23: 1.

LESSON PASSAGE: Acts 21: 40 to 22: 4; 24: 14 - 16; 26: 19 - 23.

A Rich Boyhood, 1 - 3. Paul was a favoured boy. He was brought up in Tarsus, a fine city. He was taught by Gamaliel, one of the greatest of Hebrew teachers.

A Good Conscience, 4, 11 - 16. Paul could appreciate the luxury of a good conscience because he had experienced the discomfort of a troubled conscience.

The Heavenly Vision, 19 - 21. Paul doubtless referred to his conversion. He spoke of the heavenly vision, but the experience was not momentary.

To Small and Great, 22, 23. Though Paul was one of the world's greatest thinkers, he had time for common folk. He could speak before kings and also have fellowship with tent makers, pedlars and slaves.

The SNAPSHOT GUILD

CORRECT EXPOSURE



The right exposure—corrected for each situation—yields better pictures. For this average subject, on a cloudy-bright day, 1/25 second at f.8 lens opening is correct.

NOW that spring is here, the days seem brighter as well as longer. This apparent brightness may deceive some of us into shortening our outdoor exposures—but we should be cautious in so doing.

Underexposure is the most frequent fault in amateur snapshots. A picture printed from an underexposed negative has a harsh appearance. The shadows are too black and lack detail, and by comparison the bright areas appear excessively bright.

BRILLIANT DAY: Average subject, 1/25 second at f.11 lens opening; open landscape, 1/25 second at f.16; water or beach scenes, 1/25 second at f.22.

CLOUDY BRIGHT DAY: Average subject, 1/25 second at f.8; open landscape, 1/25 at f.11; water or beach scenes, 1/25 at f.11.

DULL DAY: Average subject, 1/25 at f.6.3; open landscape, 1/25 at f.8; water or beach scenes, 1/25 at f.11.
