The Lorne Scots "P.D.&H." Regiment Needs You to bring the complement up to strength

Never before has the necessity been so great for men for the Reserve Army. It's Canada's equivalent to England's famous Home Guard where men in all walks of life are doing their part. Colonels and Majors of World War 1 now serve in the ranks, Doctors, Lawyers, Bankers, Merchants, Business Executives, Factory Workers, and Artisans are all eligible for the reserve army, if they can't go active.

To be eligible for the Lorne Scots Reserve, a man must belong to one of seven age groups: 17 and 18 years of age, single men 42½ to 50 years, married men 28½ to 50 years, Great War veterans up to 55 years (these four are open to men of categories "A", "B" and "C"), all men 17 to 50 years in category "C". Those who have received Active Army postponement and those who have been rejected for Active Service.
