**Retailers Hear Talk on Post-War Merchandising Problems**

At an open meeting, sponsored by the Retail Division of the Georgetown Board of Trade last Wednesday evening in the Municipal Building, C. W. Westlake, resident manager of the National Cash Register Co., Hamilton, was guest speaker.

Speaking on the subject "Merchandising — a Post-War Problem," Mr. Westlake brought a message of interest to his audience, pointing out some of the factors which will enter future merchandising, and the necessity of planning to meet the various problems. He pointed out how merchants had benefited in the last few years from the adoption of decent closing hours, the elimination of charge accounts and the curtailment of delivery services, and said that cooperation was necessary to continue such benefits.

He suggested that retailers keep proper records, acquire the ability to get along with customers and employees and make plans for physical improvement of business places.

Introducing the speaker, President A. R. Speight drew the meeting's attention to a letter appearing in the issue of the Herald just off the press that night. The letter criticized the Board of Trade for pressing for new industries, sewage and high school improvements, etc. and asked if the water supply and costs had been taken into consideration. Mr. Speight said that he was glad to see that a citizen had given so much time and thought to the letter and that he believed the Board of Trade was really getting somewhere when such a letter had

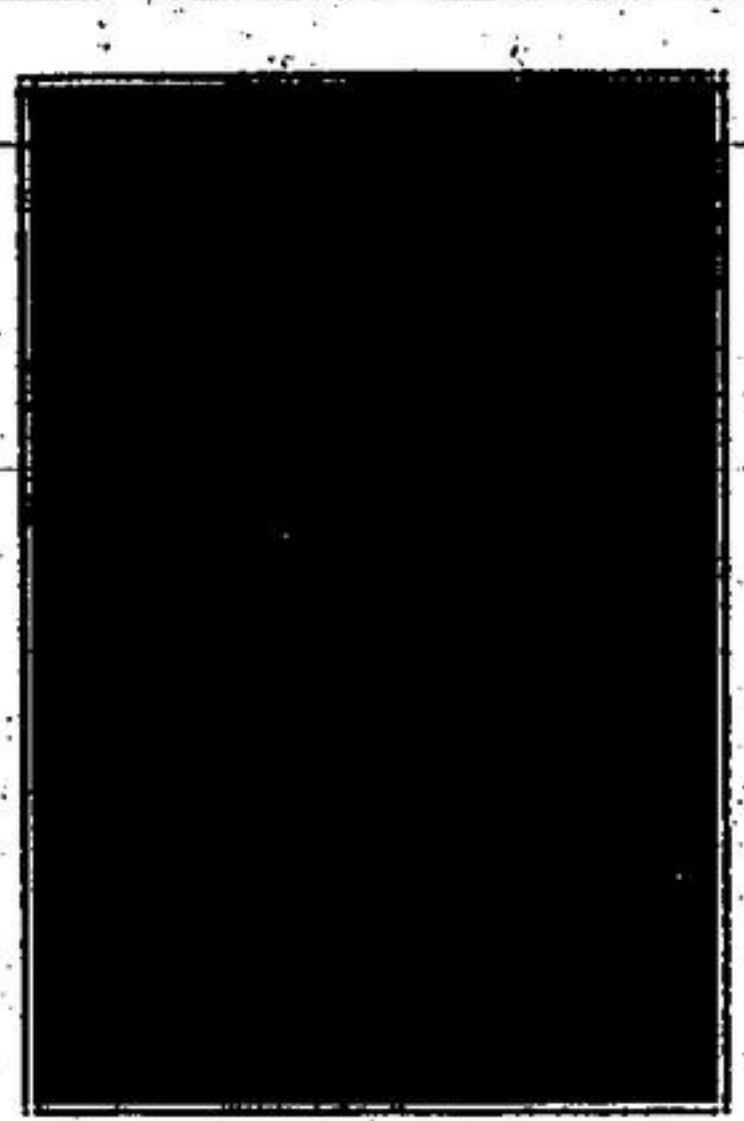
been written. He then went on to suggest other things which the Board of Trade could think of, including building by-laws, elimination of the traffic hazard at the ONR culvert, etc.

At the close of the meeting, a discussion took place about securing suitable parking facilities for downtown shoppers, and the president and secretary were asked to make further enquiries with a view to securing a suitable property for the convenience of shoppers.

**FUNERAL OF THE LATE VICTOR VANNATTER IN BARRIE**

Victor Lorne Vannatter, beloved husband of Jane Sinclair, died suddenly, Monday, Feb. 19th, 1945 at Three Rivers, Que. He was in his 62nd year and passed away following a heart attack. He had been troubled with this condition for 12 years, but the day he died he had felt very well. He had written a letter to his wife in Barrie saying how well he was feeling.

Victor Lorne Vannatter was born Feb. 29, 1884, the son of Mr. and Mrs. Erastus Vannatter, Georgetown. He attended schools there and in 1897 married Jane Sinclair, who lived in nearby Erin. They made their home at Georgetown for four years and then lived in Aurora for six years. As Aurora Mr. Vannatter was employed by Underhill's Limited, a shoe factory. About 28 years ago he came to Barrie to work for the same firm and he continued with them for many years. For three years he had operated a shoe repair business of his own. Since early in the war Mr. Vannatter had been employed by the Inspection Board Leather Products, for the United Kingdom and Canada. He had served this board in Brampton, Aurora, Kitchener, and travelled from Halifax to Vancouver and was inspecting army shoes in Quebec when he died.

He had been a member of the Odd-fellows' Lodge, was a member of the Presbyterian Church, and when in Barrie was a very active lawn bowler.

Surviving, in addition to his wife, are two daughters, Jean at home and Mrs. Stephen (Amanda) Hines, and a son, Gordon, Barrie. The body was brought from Three Rivers to Barrie. The funeral

service, Friday, Feb. 23, was conducted by Rev. James Ferguson at his late home on Dunlop St. Interment was in Barrie Union Cemetery. The pallbearers were Lewis Caldwell, Jack Garner, J. V. Hatch, Geo. Coles, Alex Cleland and Cecil McMillin. There were numerous floral tributes from friends and relatives. Among the organizations who have flowers were: I.O.O.F. 63, Barrie; Robb's Lodge, Barrie; Inspection Board Leather Products; Underhill's Limited; Underhill's Employees; Chrysler Agency, Toronto; degree staff of Robb's; Active Service Canteen Staff.

The funeral was largely attended. Those from a distance were: J. V. Hatch, Inspection Board of the United Kingdom and Canada; Mr. and Mrs. Mino, Joseph Finley, Mr. and Mrs. Johnson, all of Toronto, and Fred, William, Stewart and Helen Sinclair and Mrs. H. Graham, Georgetown, — Barrie Examiner.
