Two district soldiers arrived in time to celebrate V-E Day at home last week in the persons of Pte. George Riddall and Lt. Joseph Standish who reached Georgetown on Saturday, after lengthy service overseas.

Enlisting with the 11th Field Ambulance in London, Pte. Riddall had been overseas since September, 1940, after training at London, Guelph and Camp Borden. At time of enlistment he was employed with Weston's Bread Co. in Guelph. A veteran of Dieppe, he has served in France, Holland, Belgium and Germany. Prominent in local sports circles, "Porgie" did some boxing overseas and fought professionally in Liverpool in 1941.
