Sunday School Lesson
LAWSON'S Bible Class, 9 to 10
Lesson for March 21: 1:16-22
1 SAMUEL 13:1-14
A NATION'S WEALTH AND STRENGTH
Having achieved many successes of political unity because of an underlying spiritual unity achieved under the leadership of Samuel, and having tasted the fruits of victory over their enemies which such unity produced, the Hebrew tribes became firm converts to the principle that in unity there is strength, and in this week's lesson we see them demanding complete political unity under a king. Wise men that he was, Samuel attempted to show them that God, and a king, was the real source of their strength, and that real unity was spiritual unity which comes from common worship of, and obedience to, God. Samuel has often been accused of jealousy, because he opposed the appointment of a king. It was not jealousy but a practical wis-

dom which gave the necessity of spiritual unity. The foundation of a nation's strength is a spiritual unity. This was not at all to signify that these men ruled by divine right. Neither did it signify that there was a higher authority in the hand than the king, than even the people who held the king, and that the king ruled only under God's authority, and only so long as he recognized that authority and the laws thereof. Under David, the Hebrew nation became strong. Not only were the Philistines conquered, but the territorial holdings of the Hebrews were considerably extended and consolidated. Israel became a great power. With power came wealth as under Solomon and as wealth increased, so did injustice; and so did the power of the king. All that Samuel had foreseen concerning the kingship came to pass, the king became the object of supreme loyalty rather than God. In the end, the Kingdom was divided, and ultimately became the prey of powerful nations such as Egypt, Assyria, Babylon, Macedonia and Rome. The Hebrews were scattered to the ends of the earth.

The moral? Politics unity is a farce rather than a force without an underlying spiritual unity. Either within a nation or in the international order political unity is possible only in a unity of ideology. And if the ideology is contrary to the law of God—in any way, or presupposes tyranny, unity cannot be permanent. The only true unity can come as citizens and nations are true to Christian ideology. By that we mean that the only unity in which there is strength is unity in Christ. Only as the nations recognize an authority higher than their governments, will World Government be possible, and only as the World Government recognizes a power in a moral universe higher than itself, can it succeed.

CANCER

Next to heart disease, cancer is the greatest single cause of death on this continent. It kills 1,000 Canadians every month. One out of every eight persons now living must expect to die of cancer, unless far-reaching preventive measures are taken.

Cancer is a deadly killer unless the patient seeks early medical advice. But when caught in its early stages, cancer is generally curable.

The cause of cancer is still unknown, and there is yet no specific cure. But if diagnosed in time and treated by surgery, x-ray or radium, a cure can be effected in a majority of all cancer cases.

It is now proposed to organize an energetic campaign in Ontario against cancer in all its forms. This campaign will have the following objectives:

- 1—To organize and operate fully equipped cancer clinics at suitable centres, where people may be examined, and, if necessary, treated according to the most scientific methods.
- 2—To pay a portion of the cost of treatment of cancer for those needing financial help.
- 3—To pay travelling expenses to and from clinics, if needed.
- 4—To conduct an energetic program of cancer research.

To carry out this program, the first need is money. Your donation will definitely help to reduce the number of deaths from cancer in this province. It will help hundreds of people to be medically examined in time and to escape from the deadly clutches of cancer. It may well help research scientists to discover a cure for cancer and so free mankind forever from the dread scourge of cancer.

This appeal is for an objective of \$2,000,000 to provide for a three-year program of cancer research, treatment and province-wide service.

Jobs Follow Organization

But Employers and Workers Must Assist

During the war organization of manpower was made possible through co-operation of employers and workers.

This co-operation is no less necessary to assist in organizing the employment market during the present critical period.

Some manpower controls still remain. These are still law. They are aimed at assisting in organizing the employment market.

Remaining controls are designed to help employers and workers—and actually require only minor assistance from the public.

YOU ARE URGED TO COMPLY WITH THE FOUR CONTROLS WHICH REMAIN:

- 1—Employers MUST notify the National Employment Office of any need for workers, as soon as that need is known.
- 2—Where employers engage workers outside the National Employment Service they MUST notify the nearest NES Office within three days, that an employee has been engaged. (Form NSS 312 is provided for this purpose.)
- 3—Unemployed workers seeking employment MUST register with the National Employment Office if unemployed for seven consecutive days.
- 4—Generally speaking, any employer or employee MUST give seven days' notice to the other party of any intention to terminate employment. (Form NSS 120 is still required.) Exceptions may be learned from the nearest NES Office.

The partners to industry—employers and employees—should help the National Employment Service to promote a high level of employment by complying with these simple rules.

Only with public support can an employment service give full assistance to the community.

Make full use of the Local Office of the National Employment Service. It is there to serve your needs, and those of the entire Community.
