A detailed PROGRESS REPORT covering results obtained in exploration and diamond drilling from the inception to April 20th, 1946, together with details of the Company's program for shaft sinking and underground developments, is being mailed to all shareholders of record. A summary is given below.

Sulphide Zone

As a result of 16,838.5 feet of diamond drilling completed on the main Sulphide Zone of your Company's property in the Porcupine Mining District, an area of 900 feet by 900 feet square has been blocked out. In this section there is an indicated 180,000 tons of commercial ore estimated to average \$8.80 per ton.

Conditions in this ore body suggest, however, that the ore may be mineable over an average width of 24 feet, in which event there would be an estimated 1,080,000 tons of ore, in the section blocked out, which there is reason to believe will average up to commercial value.

Shaft Sinking
and Underground
Development

Based on these results the Company's engineer advised further diamond drilling to be unnecessary at this point, and recommended the immediate sinking of a three-compartment shaft to a vertical depth of 435 feet.

A complete mining plant has therefore been purchased, and is on the site. A contract for shaft sinking has been made, and the work is to commence immediately.

The shaft is expected to intersect the junction of two sections of the Sulphide formation at 180 feet to 200 feet. A station will be cut at 180 feet. At that level, and at 400 feet, crosscuts will be driven to work the ore body.

Other Ore
Indications

Further to these developments on the main Sulphide Zone, diamond drilling in the north section of the Company's properties has picked up the continuity of a strong sulphide zone coming into Malga ground from the adjoining Carshaw property. Drilling on this zone by Carshaw is reported to have indicated 94,000 tons of ore of average \$14.00 value. The line of strike of this new discovery is protected for more than 2,000 feet on Malga ground.

Complete
Progress Report
