Stamp collecting has become the world's greatest hobby. Every nationality — people of all ages, from all walks of life are crowding the stamp counters today. Mail orders are at their peak and seldom a week passes without a spirited auction sale being held in one of the larger cities of the continent. Stamp dealers in the United States alone report their gross business exceeded \$27 million last year. This figure is more than double their pre-war turn-over.

There are several good reasons for this up-swing. People have more money to spend, but dealers do not feel that this is the basic reason for the trend. They rightly contend that no matter how much money people may have they will not spend it on a square of perforated paper unless that particular piece of paper has some significant value. Most stamp experts state that the war has been the greatest factor in creating interest in this fascinating hobby. It has brought thousands of new devotees into the brotherhood of stamp collecting. Soldiers and sailors on every battle front learned for the first time that an interesting hobby is a source of great relaxation. Stamp collecting was most practical. They collected stamps of every description and sent them home to their wives, sweethearts and children. Collections started in this manner are cherished things and the service personnel are keeping their hobbies active today.

Not long ago a mother who lost her boy in Italy was showing a beautiful collection of stamps to some of her friends. She was asked if her boy was able to send so many stamps.

"No," she answered. "Jim started sending me stamps when he first went to England. After that stamps came with every letter. When the letters stopped, somehow, I just had to keep the collection growing. It has become something of a memorial to Jim."

Stamps have always interested children. Many educators have begun to realize the value of such hobbies and hundreds of schools in Canada, England and the United States now devote

some time in the week to Glass Stamp Clubs. Teachers recognize that a postage stamp has tremendous instructional value. Hence the new growth of an old hobby.

This Fall the Georgetown Recreational Council intend to sponsor a postage stamp exhibition which will be open to collectors of all ages who reside in Georgetown or vicinity. Now is a good time to start preparing your collection.

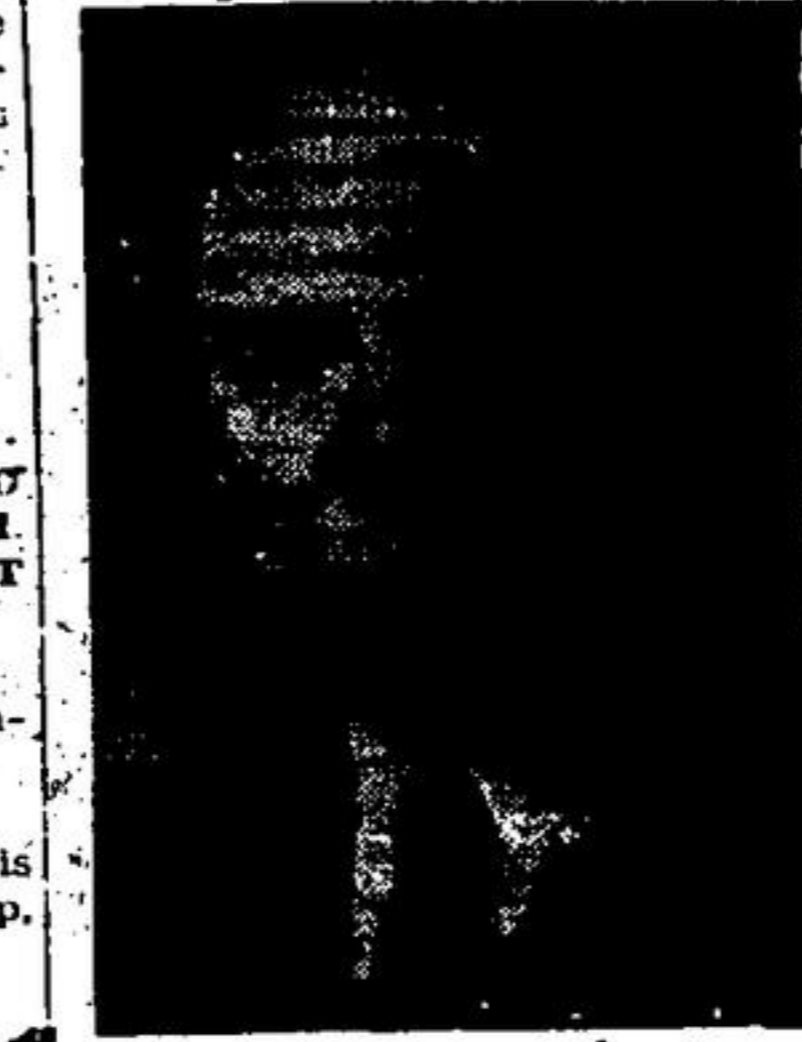

Mr. P. J. F. Dolan, who has been Assistant to the Manager, has been appointed Secretary-Treasurer.

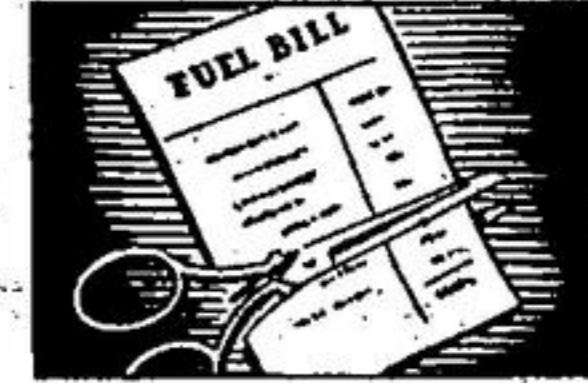

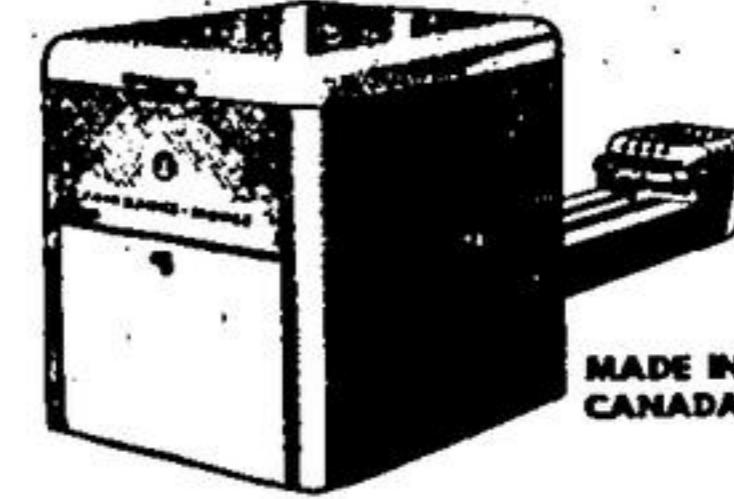
