

**SURVEY FOR WARTIME HOUSING NEARING COMPLETION**

Plans are rapidly nearing completion for the building of Veterans' homes on the Cedarvale School property fronting the highway across from the Dominion Seed House. The offer of \$550 an acre has been accepted by the United Church, which owns the property, and the town will buy from 8 to 10 acres, depending on the survey which is being completed. An agreement is being signed with War-time Housing to build the houses and it is hopeful that work can be commenced this month.
