In answer to a request from Georgetown Council for information about the policing of municipalities, Inspector

Doyle of Toronto appeared at a meeting of the Council yesterday atternoon to explain the plan.

The Onjario Provincial Police Force recommends a force of three provincial policemen for Georgetown. The municipality would be responsible for salaries of \$1750 each, plus a six cents a nule car allowance. The government would supply car, uniforms and equip ment. Each policeman, would have one day a week off, arranged in such way that two would always be on husband of Clara Campbell, in his call; also a three-week vacation, during which time the Dept. would be responsible for the policing.

Inspector Doyle said that members of the present police force would be entitled to apply for the positions and would be given some consideration.

The meeting was for purposes of information only and no action was debated by Council.
