Anthony Adamson Explains Town Planning To Board of Trade

Anthony Adamson, president Town Planning, Consultants, Ltd. and lecturer at the School of Architecture aid, Secretary of the Maple Unit. Toat the University of Toronto, spoke on day we understand that 86. Halton town planning at a meeting of last Wednesday evening.

"The problem," said Mr. Adamson, s what to do with these horrible things we have built." He admitted the impossibility of doing much with large cities, but said that a small town like Georgetown was in the fortunate position of being able to plan for future expansion and eradicate any present day difficulties. He defined town planning as the finding of solutions to the problems of an area by application of informed foresight.

Two important factors in this are the drafting of an official plan and the introduction of a zoning by-law to implement this. The official plan must have the sanction of the town Council and must be flexible and kept






