The listed necipes are those we have tested and are happy to have on file. Pickles provide zest to winter meals and those which can accompany many foods are most useful. We believe these are easy-to-make and score on colour. consistency and flavour.

Spiced Gooseberries

21/2 qts. of berries, 1 cup of vinegar. 2 lbs. sugar, 1 tbsp. cinnamon, % tsp.

alispice, % tsp. cloves. Out off the tails and stems of the berries. Bring the sinegar and sugar to boiling point and add the spices, then add the gooseberries and simmer slowly for about 20 minutes. Bottle in small airtight jars.

Pear Chow Chow

pers, 1/2 cup sugar, 2 cups vinegar, 1/2 roughly. Add vinegar, sugar, spices

Peel onions, remove seeds from peppers, put both through food chopusing coarse knife. Peel and core pears. Out in small cubes. Mix sugar, spices, salt and vinegar. Heat then cook slowly until thick, taking to boiling point. Add onions, peppers, care not to let it stick to the bottom bag. Hot Dog Relish

3 pounds (12 to 15) sweet red peppers, 3 pounds (12 to 15) green peppers. 3 pounds (12 to 15 medium) onions, 4 cups vinegar, 1 cup sugar, tsp. mustard seed, 1 tbsp. dry mustard, 1 tbsp. celery seed, 2 tbsp. salt. Reel onions, remove seeds from peppers, put both through food choppers, using coarse knife. Place in large preserving kettle, cover with boiling wa-8 pears, 3 onions, 3 sweet red pep- ter, let stand 5 minutes. Drain tho-

cook until vegetables are tender - about 10 minutes, stirring occasionally. Pour into hot jars. Seal. Yield: 6 pints.

Powdered spices make a dark coloured chutney, whereas the whole spices leave a lighter relish. If you substitute whole spices for powdered mixtures use a little extra quantity. Soaking cucumbers and onions in

strong brine causes them to wrin-Cider vinegar has a stronger aro-

ma than the Obleached vinegars, but may cause onions and celery to darken slightly. Do not cook spicey sauces

long. Vinegar and spices help to retard chemical action.

The Question Box Mrs. C. B. asks: Recipe for Pickled

#### Pickled Peaches

Answer:

8 lbs. ripe peaches, whole cloves, 1/2 cup water, 2 cups cider vinegar, 21/2 cups sugar, 3 theps. stick cinnamon, 1 tbsp. root ginger, 2tbsps. of mixed pickling spice, 1/2 lemon, thinly sliced.

Use large, firm peaches. Scald, skin and cut them in falves; stick two of three whole cloves in each half. Combine the vinegar, water, sugar, spices, (tied in a cheesecloth bag) and the lemon slices; boil for five minutes. Simmer the peaches in the syrup, one layer at a time until tender; lift into sterile jars; fill to overflowing with the boiling syrup and seal at once. Yield: approximately 4 pints.

Miss M. T. asks: Recipe for Mint Answer:

#### Mint Pears

Pare, core and put in slightly salted water, to prevent discoloration. Pack into prepared jars and fill-with medturn syrup to within 11/2 inches of top of jar. For each qt. add 1/4 tsp. mint extract and enough pure green fruit coloring to give desired shade. Add flavoring and fruit coloring to syrup before filling jars. Partially seal and process in electric oven for 1 hour at 275 degrees P.

Mrs. J. G. asks: What has made my crabapple jelly very dark? Answer: It is the result of too slow

Mrs. T. C. asks: Our current jelly has sugar crystals in the bottom of the jars. Should it be boiled again? Answered Not, it will keep as it is. Crystals are caused either because sugar was not stirred until dissolved or jelly was boiled too long.

A purebred Holstein owned by James R. Henderson, Portsmouth Ontario, has given a total of 201,392 lbs. milk containing 6,966 lbs. fat during her lifetime on Record of Performance test. She is Supreme Ruby Echo and she completed her records on twice-a-day milking. Only two cows in the world have ever completed official lifetime records of over 200,000 lbs. milk on twice-a-day milking. Both are Canadian Holsteins, the other being Meadowbrae Echos Rosebud owned by Q. D. Whale, Alma, Ontario, with a total of 203,810 Bos. milk containing 6.364 lbs. fat. Ruby is again on test and has milked up to 78 lbs. daily so that if all

goes well she will substantially add to her lifetime production in her current

lactation.
