NEW TELEPHONE DIRECTORIES ISSUED IN GEORGETOWN

Expected to be in town for the next 12 months, more than 1,300 new arrivals came to Georgetown last week and found no difficulty at all in finding places to stay. Accommodated in boarding houses, hotels, residences, and even in the fire station, they are Georgetown's brand new telephone directories.

Clasp and fresh, with green covers, the new books, largest in the community's history, now take over the duties so ably performed during the past by their well-thumbed, buff-covered predecessors. An indispensable adjunct to the social and business life of the community, the directory is frequently the first resort in time of sickness, accident or other emergency, and on occasion has been credited with saving lives.

Because the new directory has nearly 3,300 new and revised listings, a number in the Georgetown section, W. O. Misener, Bell Telephone manager for this area, urges telephone users to refer to it before placing local and district calls. "In that way," he added, "the wrong number nuisance will be greatly reduced and the standard of service maintained."

Mr. Misener also suggested that subscribers discard the old directory with its outdated listings in order to avoid referring to it in error.

The new telephone book is also being distributed to Bell subscribers in Aurora, Brampton, Newmarket, Orangeville, Shelburne and Sutton.

Monthly Meeting of Children's Aid Society

The regular monthly meeting of The Children's Aid Society was held in the Society Office, Milton, on October 14th. Owing to the absence of the President, Mr. William Deans, Vice-President, presided. Accounts for the month of September amounting to \$726.49 were passed for payment.

In response to a recent appeal for financial assistance, the Treasurer reported having received nine donations to date totalling \$133.00 which was most gratifying to the members.

Owing to the scarcity of trained Social Workers throughout the Province, to date the Society have not been able to engage the services of a qualified Worker as decided upon earlier in the year.

There were 97 children in the care of the Society at the end of the month. The Superintendent reported a steady demand for suitable infants for adoption, the applications being greatly in excess of the children available; but difficulty is encountered in obtaining suitable foster homes for older wards of the Society. At the end of the month there were 79 Child Protection Cases open, 22 of these being new contacts; delinquency, separation of parents and non-support being the chief factors in the new cases reported.
