**BY-LAW NO. 819**

Of the Municipal Corporation of the County of Halton to Restrict and Regulate the cutting of Trees and Enact the following:

**THE COUNCIL OF THE CORPORATION OF THE COUNTY OF HALTON ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:**

- Except for dead, broken, stunted, fire-damaged, diseased or insect infested trees, Christmas trees and other trees that should be removed to improve growing conditions (such as thinning and improvement cutting), no cedar tree of a diameter of less than seven inches, or twenty-two in circumference, nor any other tree of a diameter of less than fourteen inches, or forty-four inches in circumference, measured stump high, (approximately eighteen under above the ground), shall be cut by any person within the County of Halton except as hereinafter provided.
- Where in the opinion of the Trees Conservation Commission special circumstances exist which warrant the cutting of trees under the size hereinafter mentioned, the said Commission may authorize the cutting of such undersize trees.
- In cutting or removing any trees, no person shall so conduct his operations as to unnecessarily injure or damage any young trees adjacent thereto.
- No person shall cut trees or carry on lumbering or other forest operations adjacent to provincial, County and Township roads within the County of Halton unless there shall be left along the said road or roads a belt of trees sixty-six feet in width from the limit of the road allowance from which may be removed only such trees as may be approved and marked by someone authorized by the Trees Conservation Commission hereinafter established by this by-law.
- This by-law shall not:
  - interfere with the right of the occupant of land to cut trees for his own use;
  - interfere with any rights or powers conferred upon a Municipality by the Municipal Act;
  - interfere with the rights or powers of the Hydro Electric Power Commission of Ontario or of any other Board or Commission which is performing its functions for, or on behalf of the Government of Ontario;
  - apply to trees growing upon any highway or upon any opened road allowance;
  - apply to trees growing in a woodlot having an area of not exceeding two acres;
  - Any person who violates the provisions of this by-law shall be guilty of an offence and liable to a penalty not exceeding \$500.00 or to imprisonment for a term not exceeding three months.
