All who survice of a once happy prospenous farm home of 42-year old Elmo Howey are 11 year old Kenneth, in London hospital suffering from Bright's disease, and 7year old Mary Lou who was tossed clear of the cab and slightly injured when her father's stalled truck was bashed by the locomotive.

The other five of the family were snuffed out or died as the result of the accident. Instantly killed were the father, 15-year old James, William (13) and George (9). The 40year old wife and mother of five who learned of the tragedy by coincidence shortly after it had happened died later of a broken heart.

Making a sympathetic comment) on this most tragic level-crossing acident of recent months, W. G. Robertson, generalf manager of the Ontario Motor League said, "Constant attention to the job of driing is the only sure way of safety and this terrible toll illustrates the need for greater respect for all level crossings. Safety engineers agree," Mr. Robertson declared, "that inattention is the most prolific cause of accidents on our streets' and highways.".
