

THE SUNDAY SCHOOL LESSON

THE HOLY SPIRIT

by Rev. R. C. Todd LESSON: John 14:25,26; Acts 2 1-4: 4:31; Gal. 5:22-26,

In these lessons on Christian docrine, we have considered "what we know about God" and "What we know about Jesus." .We_must now come to the third Person in the Holy Trinity, and speak of "What we know about the Holy Spirit." Historic Christianity has always Witnessed to the furt that the Holy Spirit is the One true God with the Vather and the Son, and of one authtance with them! - .. 1. It is important to realize that we could know- nothing either of he Father or of the Son, either of God or of Jesus: -in a Christian sense, except through the revelution of the Holy Spirit. The word "Comforter" in John .14:26 carries he meaning Teacher" or "Counsellor." St. Paul says: "No man can say that Jesus' is Lord but by the Holy Spirit (1 Cor. 12:3). Read John 14:26 carefully in this light We have spoken and are accustomed to speak of the forgiveness of sins, of reconciliation of sinful man to Holy God, of a new birth, of the Church, of eternal life, as the concern of God for man. "God so loved the world . . . (John 3: 16). But these things become the Dossession of man through the Holy Spirit. The Revelation of God in Christ is-made known through the Holy Spirit and the reconciliation of the world to God in Christ, made through the Holy Spirit. The Holy Spirit is God coming to man in such a way that God is known to man, and man believes in Jesus Christ and is reconciled to God. The work of the Holy Spirit is to convince men of sin -- of their own sin : - and to prepare them for the reception of God's reconciling Word. Man cannot so prepare himself. Chri tian believers of all ages will bear witness to the truth of the statement made by Martin Luther: I believe that I cannot by my own ivason andgatrength believe in Jesus Christ my Lord; or come to Him".
