The plot will be planted with trees chosen by the owner of the land, who is asked to durrow the plot in preparation for the planting, and to protect the plantation from livestock. The children of your School Section will do the planting, under the supervision of a representative of the Department of Lands and Forests; it is expected that the trees will receive reasonable care during the summer. A proportion of the points in the competition are awarded for survival of the trees.
