There always was a good market for sea food and naturally the Scilly fishing industry is nationalized. It belongs to all the people. When big money is made, everybody profits in the spirit of real progressive democracy. When the boats come in, their catch is carefully inspected and weighed by the Scilly B.S. (Bustem Service). If fishermen bring in too much, the surplus is dumped overboard. Thus, the price of fish is always right, carefully computed by the B.S. efficiency expert, according to man hours per pound of rough dry.
