The resignation of H. A. Speers, new Grade 7 teacher at Georgetown Public School, was accepted by the school board at their meeting on Wednesday night. Mr. Speers gave as his reason the fact that he had not been able to find living quarters in town and that he was contemplating a business merger, and gave thirty days notice.

Mr. Speers was hired by the board last spring to replace Mr. Samuel Stévenet, who resigned after teaching here a year to take a school closer to his home. He was to teach Grade 7 and Manual Training. The board has advertised for a replacement.

MARKSMAN SON BRINGS \$2,250 AT OAKVILLE SALE

Bond Haven Rag Apple Masterpiece, three year old son of the five times All-Canadian "Marksmen" brought \$2,550 to top the Fifth Oakville Consignment Sale held September 2nd at the Oakville Sales Arena. "Masterpiece" is out of a 1087 lb. "Very Good" granddaughter of Lonelma Texal Payne and was purchased by the Oxford Holstein Breeders' Association for use artificially.

This was an outstanding consignment sale with the 48 head offered averaging \$527. for a total of \$22,690. Highest price for a female was \$950 paid by C. S. Erb and Co., Middletown, Pa., to Jack Wauchope, Schomberg, Ont. for Lynnden Hermit-Daisy, a four-year-old daughter of Lynnden Hartog Daisy whose four-year-old record of 23978 lbs. milk containing 1005 lbs. fat on 2x is the second highest in Canada in its class. Elmcroft Inka L., three-year-old son of Montvic Emile Lochinvar, consigned by J. S. Whaley, Caledonia, Ontario, was purchased by Thos. Hays, Brampton for \$925.

One of the classiest fields in Canadian golfing history will tee off late this month over the Shaughnessy Golf Club course in Vancouver in the 39th Annual Canadian Open tournament for the Seagram Gold Cup and \$10,000 in prize money. Four days of medal play, starting September 22 over the par 72 Shaughnessy layout will decide who will replace South Africa's Bobby Locke as Canadian Open champion. Locke has returned to his native land and will not be defending his title.

A monument in memory of the late Lucy Maud Montgomery, author of "Anne of Green Gables" was unveiled in Prince Edward Island National Park on Sunday. The monument was erected by the National Parks Service of the Resources Department on recommendation of the Historic Sites and Monuments Board of Canada.

The book "Anne of Green Gables" was the first in a series by the popular writer, who was a native of Prince Edward Island, which cast a romantic glow over the province and gained for her international fame as a writer of girls' books. It is interesting to recall that she was once a resident of Norval where her husband served as a minister for a number of years.
