HALTON GARAGE OPERATORS' HAVE PERMAPUSE DEMONSTRATION

At their September meeting the 'Garage Operators' and their employees were given a demonstration of the new Permatuse method of brake bonding. This new method eliminates the use of rivets as a means of attaching the lining to the brake shoes.

This new process requires a thorough cleaning of the old drums by means of burring and then an application of bonding coment and s special tape. The brake lining is then clamped to the shoe and is put in a Permafuse machine which is an automatically regulated oven where the brake shoes are baked for one-half hour at 300 degrees F.

Several of the automobile manufacturers are using this method on their new cars as it gives a longer service from the brake lining and eliminates brake drum scouring from rivets.
