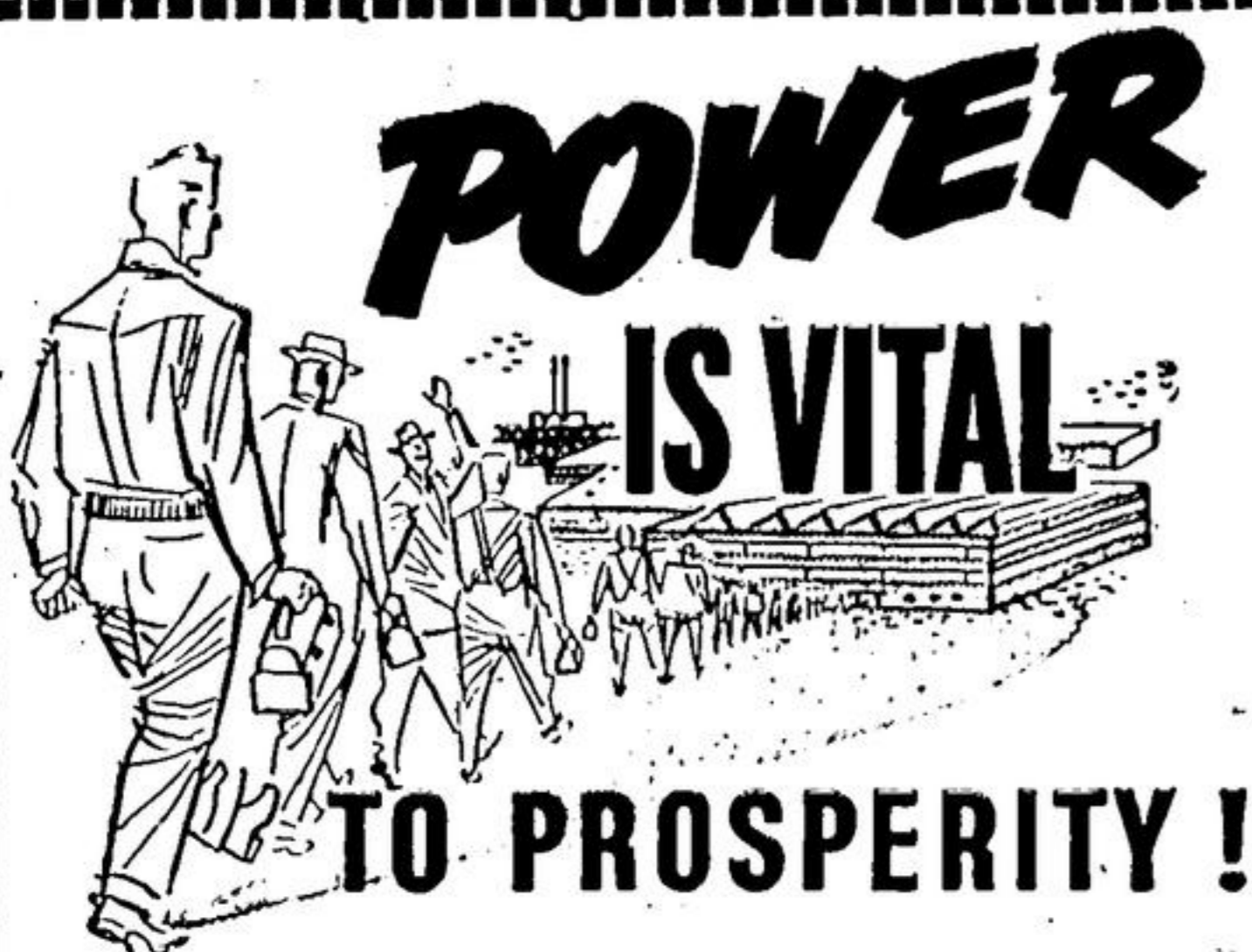

BAPTIST CHURCH HIGHLIGHTS

The riches of His Grace was the subject for the Sunday morning service. The text was taken from Ephesians 1:7. In Christ we have redemption through His blood, the forgiveness of sin, according to the riches of His Grace.

In the evening the pastor brought a message on, The Lord in the Midst. Pointing out that God wants to be in the midst of our life, our church and our community. God told the Israelites to build a tabernacle in the midst of the camp, saying He would meet with them and commune with them. Evil days came, the sanctuary was neglected and the worship of God was laid aside. God withdrew His presence to return at their call. God does not compel anyone to serve Him, it is their own free choice.

At certain periods they came back to God but would drift away again. The prophets kept burning their lamp of hope. In John 1:14 we read, the word was made flesh and dwelt among us. This was the birth of Christ. When Christ left this world He sent the Holy Spirit to be in our midst and to guide us in all truth. We find in the last chapter of the Bible, that Christ is in the midst of the throne and the elders. Just before the close, the final picture, we read of a new Heaven and a new earth, the Holy City coming down from Heaven. This wondrous drama starts on earth and finishes in heaven. It reveals two facts; 1st: That earth's highest happiness is in fellowship with Christ. 2nd: That Heaven's highest happiness is in fellowship with Christ.
