SUNDAY, APRIL 17th "THE FUTURE LIFE"

On Easter Sunday there could be no greater lesson theme than "The Future Life." In previous lessons we have been studying the life of Jesus' Christ as he journeyed toward the Cross, and we agree that the word "vicarious" is descriptive of both his life and his death. The story of Jesus, however, does not end at the Cross. Indeed the story of Jesus does, not end.
