Georgetown, November 29th, 1949

Dear Mr. Editor:  
It is interesting to note that the Police Committee has made no denial of the allegations in my letter to you dated the 7th inst. Perhaps they regard the matter as 'beyond their contempt to deal with.' If this is the case, the attitude is just typical of their exalted behaviour in most matters, apparently. Equally possible is the fact that there is no effective reply and I am assuming that this is the reason for Silence.

This being the case, you will undoubtedly excuse my enumerating once again the queries 'put in' my letter of the 7th inst.

1. Was not the Committee's announcement in "The Herald" in poor taste and from a legal standpoint, highly improper?  
2. Who paid for the advertisement?  
3. Is it the intention of the Police Committee to endeavour to get things in the local Police Court nicely "arranged" as they would like to have them?

Since there has been no denial forthcoming to date, it is quite apparent that the answers to points numbers 1 and 3 are, emphatically YES; and to point 2, the Ratepayers of Georgetown. This being the case, the Electors will know how to deal very effectively with men who sponsor such amazing conduct in Official Circles; those who threaten prosecution of Townsmen who 'trespass' on their own property, such as is the water supply source; those who threaten to depose a Magistrate unless he delivers verdicts which are to their liking. Really, gentlemen, in all experience of local and Parliamentary politics on two Continents, I have never heard of such things; except perhaps in the Dictator Countries.

By the way, gentlemen, we haven't noticed an announcement paid for personally this time by you, in which you tender your humblest apologies to the Magistrate for your recently published insinuations. Colossi of the Police Committee, perhaps you are not quite Big Enough for that, eh?
