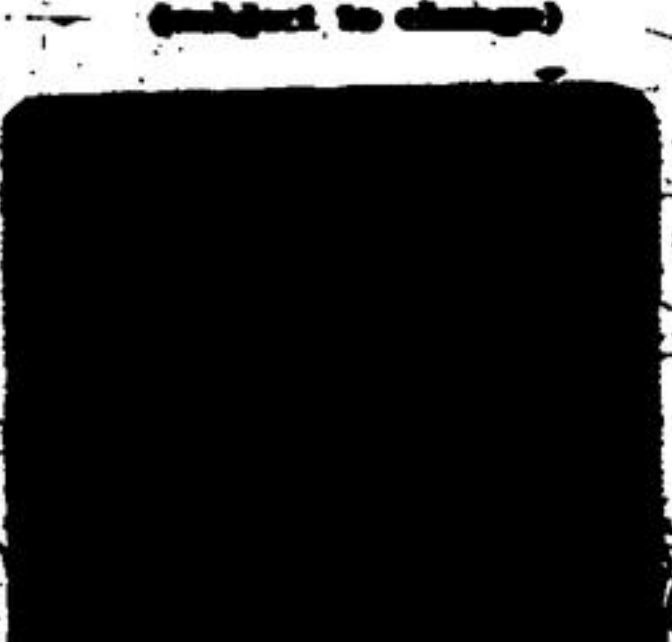

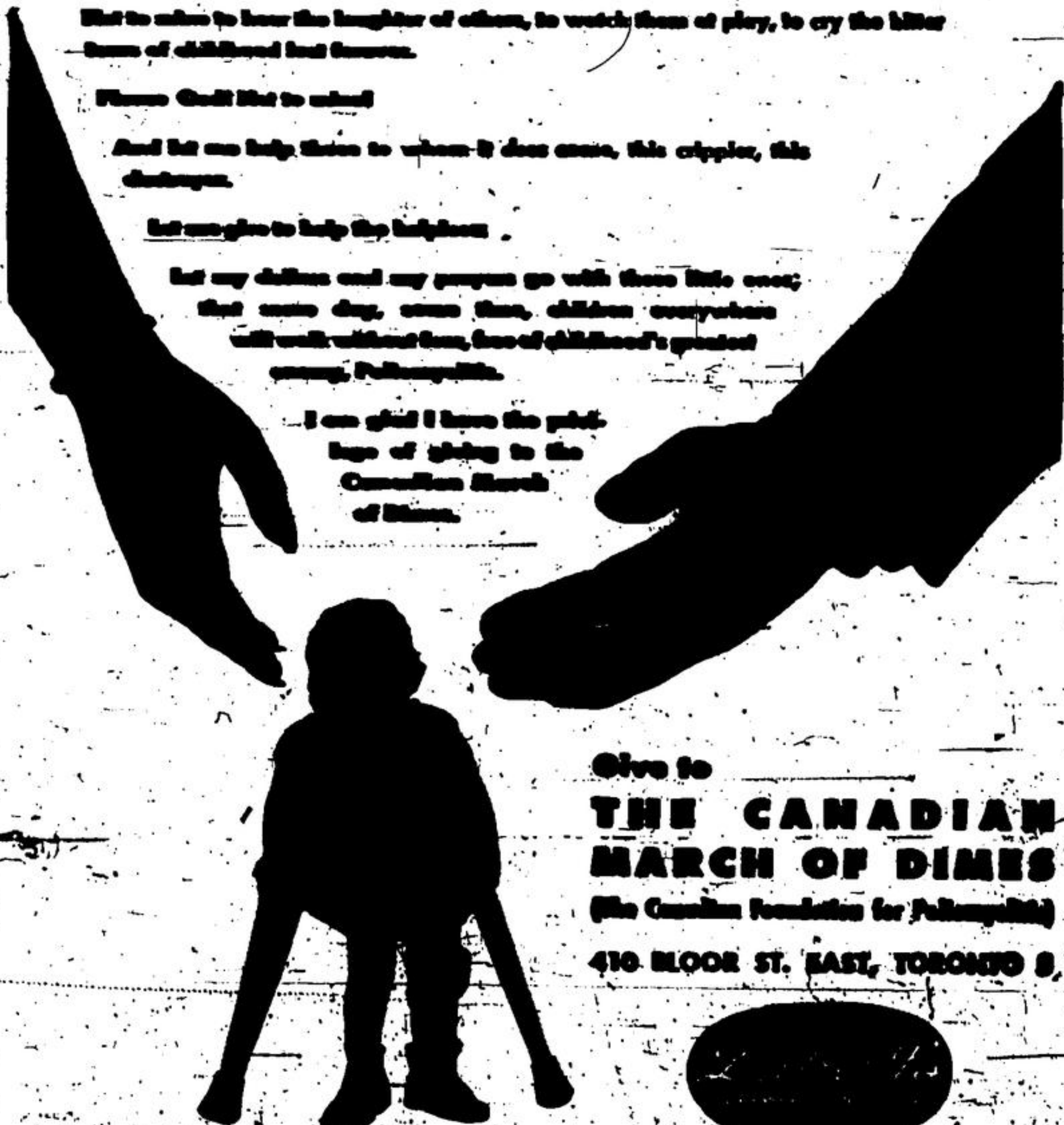
The Canadian Ski Championships, together with events of the North American and International University Championships will be held this year at Banff from Feb. 4 to March 5.
