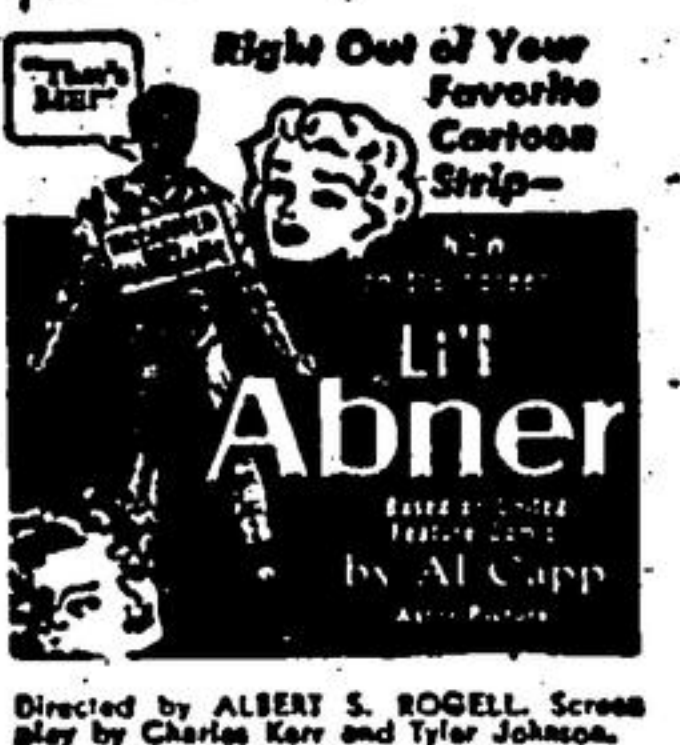
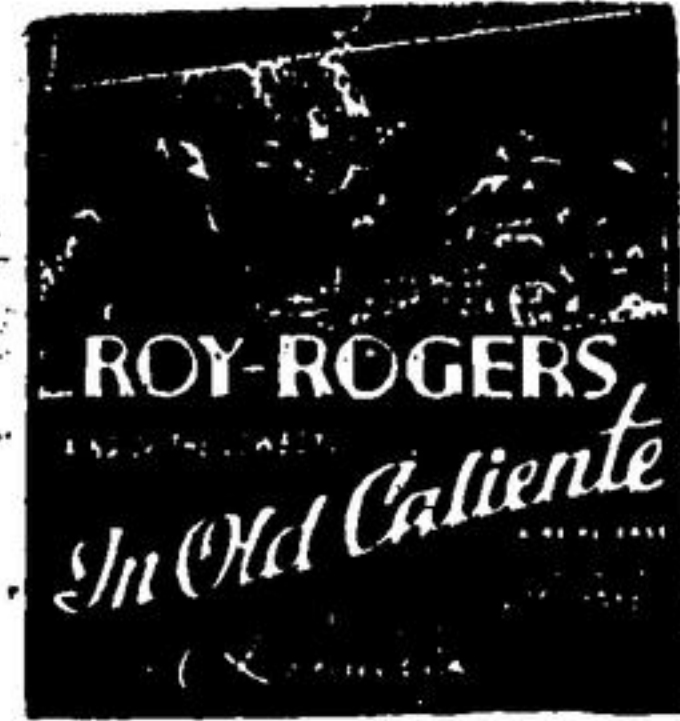

Company Employees Honor Massey-Harris President

On the occasion of his 40th anniversary in the service of the Massey-Harris Company, Limited, President James S. Duncan, CMG, was signally honoured at a dinner in Toronto on January 5th. The function was attended by over 200 of Mr. Duncan's associates from the Canadian and U.S. organizations of the Company. On behalf of those in attendance, Vice-President C. N. Appleton presented Mr. Duncan with a painting of himself executed by the outstanding Canadian portrait artist, Cleeve Horne, R.C.A., O.S.A.

Expressing the esteem of the Company's employees in all parts of the world, Mr. John Martin, Director of Public Relations, also presented Mr. Duncan with a richly bound volume containing an illuminated address and the personal signatures of almost 14,000 employees in plants and sales branches in Canada, U.S., England, Europe, South America, Africa, India, China, Mexico, New Zealand, Australia, and other lands.

In his speech of acceptance, Mr. Duncan recalled his early start in the Company's employ as office boy in the Berlin Germany branch in 1910. The following year he was sent to Canada where he gained experience in the plants at Brantford and Toronto and as a member of the Ontario branch sales force. Returning to Europe in 1914 he earned rapid promotion in the business after serving with the British forces in the first world war and was named European General Manager in 1931.

HOTELMEN HONOUR LABATT BROTHERS

In honour of their 50th anniversary of association with the company, John S. Labatt, president, and Hugh F. Labatt, vice-president and chairman of the board, of John Labatt Limited, have been presented with illuminated addresses by the Ontario Hotel Association.

The addresses were presented to the Labatt brothers, of London, Ont., at a banquet in the Royal York Hotel, Toronto, concluding the 25th annual meeting of the Ontario Hotel Association. Ward Markle, retiring president of the Association, presented the addresses to the Messrs. Labatt.

In the preamble to each of the addresses it was noted that during

the half century the Labatt brothers have been associated with the London Brewing Company "a friendly and mutually profitable association has been maintained between John Labatt Limited and the hotel industry of the province of Ontario."

Each of the addresses was composed in the old, traditional style of such tributes, the citation in each case opening with: "Know therefore all ye who are engaged in the ancient and honorable business of providing shelter and refreshment . . ."

After outlining the business, community and philanthropic careers of the two men, the addresses closed with: "Know therefore, that we, the duly appointed officers of the Hotel Association of the Province of Ontario do hereby signalize

this auspicious anniversary by expressing . . . our heartiest congratulations and good-wishes for the future."
