She was predeceased by four sisters, Etta, Janet, Mrs. J. M. Moore, (Amy) and Mrs. R. M. Wilson of Vancouver. Since her sister's death she had made her home with her niece, Mrs. W. R. S. Douglas in Toronto, moving back to Georgetown with Mr. and Mrs. Douglas when they returned to town to live in the Moore residence across from the park. While working in the garden on Thursday she suffered a coronary thrombosis which was not believed to be serious, but died quietly in her sleep on Saturday morning. Two nieces survive, Mrs. Douglas and Mrs. Jack Smethurst of Winnipeg.
