## Presbyterians Mark 75th Anniversary

(from the Montreal Gazette)  
— Seventy five years ago this month, in 1875—four independent Canadian synods came together to form the Presbyterian Church in Canada. The union took place in Montreal. And it is in this city that the Presbyterian Church is now commemorating the completion of three-quarters of a century of testimony in this land.

The union of 1875 required only the adjustment of comparatively minor differences. All four of the synods were able to join upon the great features of Presbyterian practice and the cardinal doctrines of Presbyterian faith.

But in matters of religion, doctrine serves not the year or the generations but is beyond time. And looking back today, the great doctrine of Presbyterianism—the perfect sovereignty of God—has a meaning greater and more significant than ever before.

It is this doctrine that now counteracts the modern tendencies in religion to introduce the kingdom of God by legislation or to cure the sins of mankind by psychology. It is a doctrine that places in God's will, the seat of religious experience and conviction.

This is surely a faith for these times. It confirms the belief that all the great figures of Biblical story, and all others who have taken their lonely stand for righteousness, were not men playing a merely quixotic role, splendid but futile. They were men who had been drawn to take their stand with the eternal itself and who have been justified by God and man.

Presbyterianism today is one of the faiths that has not yielded to the temptations of a religious humanism, nor has it extolled the touching nobility of man in a hostile or indifferent universe. It has preached the doctrine that the heart of the eternal can have power to claim man's heart, and that man's good fight, despite all frustrations, has the ultimate sanction.

It is in their conviction and consciousness of the unbroken continuity of clear doctrine held in faith that this week's gathering will sing with full meaning the words of the ancient hymn "O God of Bethel." Our vows, our prayers, we now present

Before Thy throne of grace:  
God of our Fathers, be the God  
Of their succeeding race.

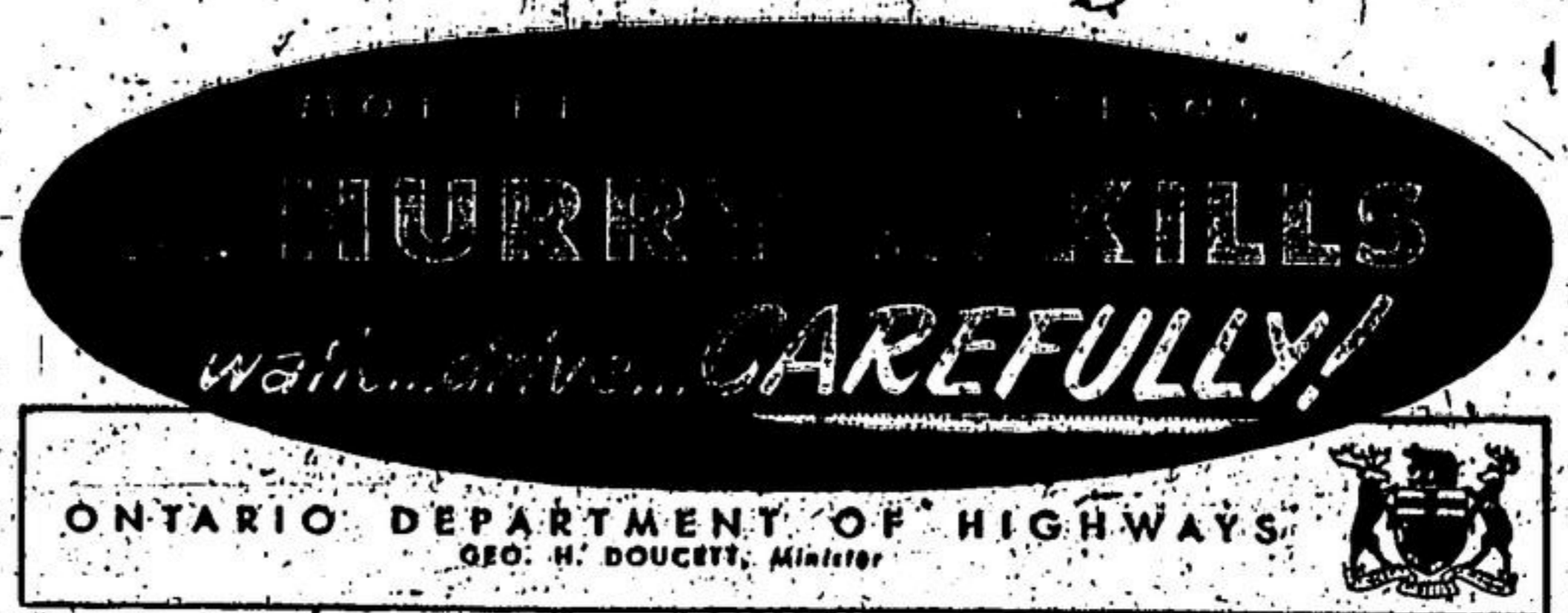
