## Institute for Blind Plans Fund Campaign

As civil society progresses and develops more and more thought and attention is given to those who are underprivileged because of physical handicap. Each year additional effort is made to rehabilitate those who are deprived of one of the five senses. The Canadian National Institute for the Blind, a pioneer in the field of Rehabilitation, is constantly striving to make the lives of sightless people more useful and pleasant by the maintenance of its broad program of services.

Today those who are deprived of vision may enjoy the pleasure of employment, good reading, special training and recreation. These were privileges denied to the sightless before the development of the Institute and its Advisory Boards, which undertake to look after the general well-being of those who are without sight.

The Halton Advisory Board is interested in the well-being of blind persons within the county. The volunteer workers, who compose the board, are anxious that the service program can be maintained and that our fellow citizens, who are without sight, shall be properly served in accordance with their individual need. Each year the local advisory board invites the general public to become shareholders in this great humanitarian work by supporting its financial campaign.
