A bylaw to amend By-law No. 427 of the Corporation of the Town of Georgetown, which is a By-law for the early closing of shops, including beauty parlours, in the Town of Georgetown.

WHEREAS it is expedient to amend the said By-law No. 427, upon presentation of a sufficient petition to the Council requesting the amendment.

Now, Therefore the Municipal Corporation of the Town of Georgetown by its Municipal Council Enacts As Follows:

By-law No. 427 being a By-law providing for the early closing of shops including beauty parlours in the Town of Georgetown is amended by deleting Section 1-(b) thereof and substituting in place thereof the amended clause 1(b) which reads as follows: The hours of closing shall be as follows:- Monday, Tuesday and Wednesday 8.30 p.m.; Thursday 12.30 p.m.; Friday 9 p.m. and Saturday 8 p.m.

In all other respects the said By-law No. 427 shall remain in full force and effect.
