Pallbearers were Albert Presswood, Cecil Barth, Archie Eccles, Jack Hancock, Harold Campbell and George Dixon. Burial was in Greenwood Cemetery, Georgetown.

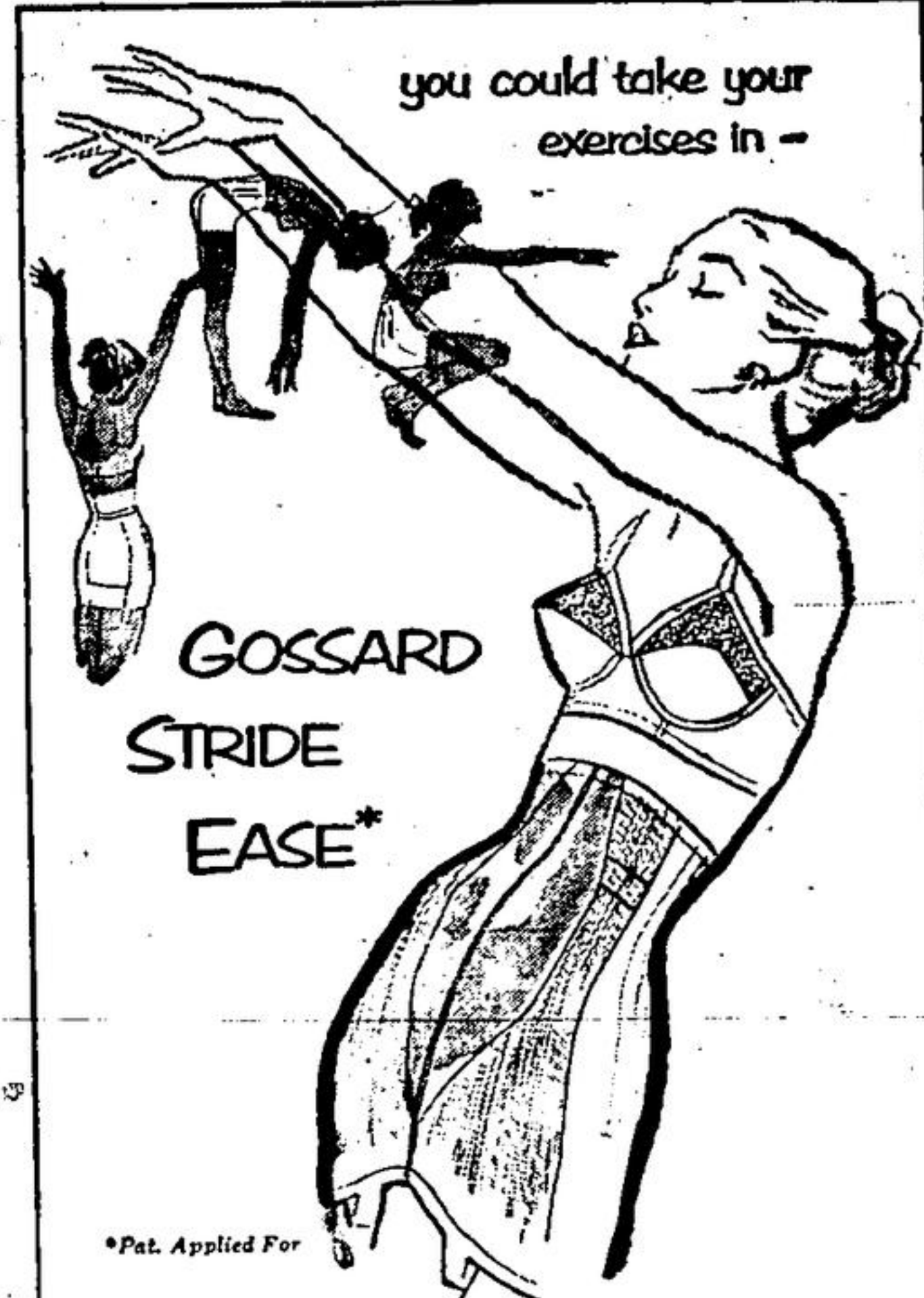
