**Continues Sermon Series On Memorial Window Theme**

Sunday morning service at St. John's United Church, was the 18th of the Memorial Window series, with the Emblem the letters 'IHS,' the symbol of the first three letters of the Greek word for Jesus, the scripture verse of the window being 'This is my beloved Son, hear ye Him.'

Rev. John M. Smith took for his text, Matt 1-21, "Thou shalt call His Name Jesus, for He shall save the people from their sins," and also the words of the window. Mr. Smith showed that the original use of these letters, I.H.S., meaning Jesus, was at a time in our Christian history when it was dangerous to one's life to be known as a Christian, hence the early followers of Jesus during persecution days, had to be wary of strangers, and used signs to make sure they were giving Christian information only where it would be safe and not endanger their own lives or those of their friends, nor hurt their own cause. This was one of the signs used, that of a fish being another familiar one.

The idea, somewhat prevalent, that the early Christians were fanatical and careless about their lives, is a wrong one. They believed they could best promote Christianity by living; it was only when they had to choose between giving up their life or their faith, that they chose to die, even by wild beasts in the arena, rather than deny the tenacious faith they had in Jesus.

Other meanings for I.H.S. which developed later were, one from Roman words with these initials, meaning "Jesus saves from sin," another was "I have suffered" used in a Christian sense, but however, interpreted, they all have a similar meaning and all point to Jesus. The Jesus of Galilee whom they knew as a man like themselves, a workman who had mixed with them, and talked with them. Yet unique in that He told them about God with authority, about love, forgiveness, sin. They soon learned that this was Jesus, the Son of God, who came from God and could tell them about their heavenly Father and His love and concern for them. Or as the centur-

ion at the cross had said: "Truly this was the Son of God."

And all the meanings for IHS point to Jesus as the source of the church. Those using this sign were so loyal in their allegiance to this Jesus, that this grew into a bond of fellowship which founded the church of whatever denomination, and has continued it down through the ages to carry on the work for which Jesus came, the redeeming of the world back to God. So IHS points to Jesus as the saviour of mankind, as prophesied at His birth, "Thou shalt call His name Jesus, for He shall save the people from their sins." Those using this sign knew Jesus as their personal Saviour, just as He is anxious to be to us today, if we will only believe.

Mr. Smith asked the congregation to use this window always as a reminder of Jesus; as a friend whom we should hear; as the source of our church which means so much to us; and as the Saviour of the world, our Saviour. If we cannot remember the original meanings of IHS, let us think of it as "In His Service."

Mr. Smith told the boys and girls of an actual happening in the church he came from, which had been told him. A small girl had got up to sing, unaccompanied and as often happens, had become frightened and her starting note would not come right. Then she saw her mother in the gallery and all her fright disappeared. She called: "Mother give me the note." Her mother did and all went well. Mr. Smith asked the boys and girls if ever they got where they didn't know what to do to be doing right, just quietly ask Jesus to give them the note, and He will and obeying, all will be well.

The choir anthem was "The Lord is my Light" with Mrs. Ruth Wrigglesworth taking the solo part. The Junior Choir sang "Jesus Son of God Most High." Mr. V. Stein sang "In the Garden" a request number.

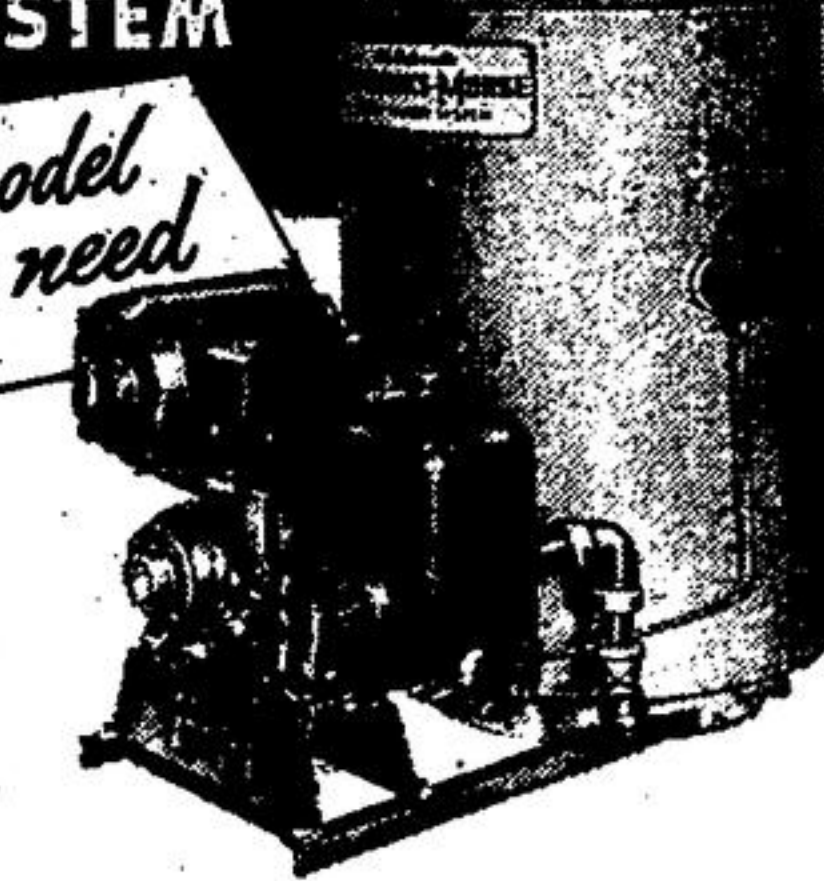

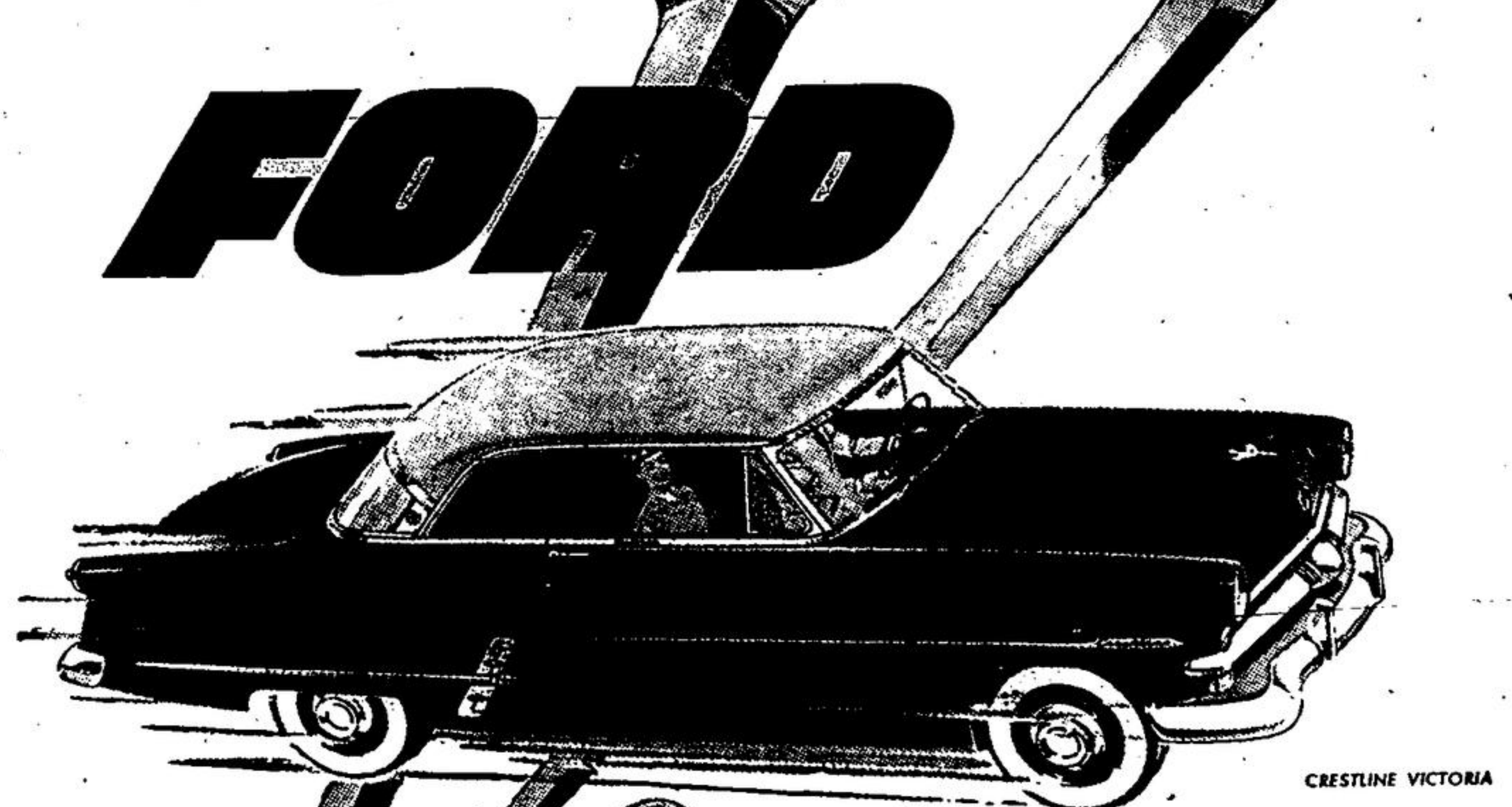

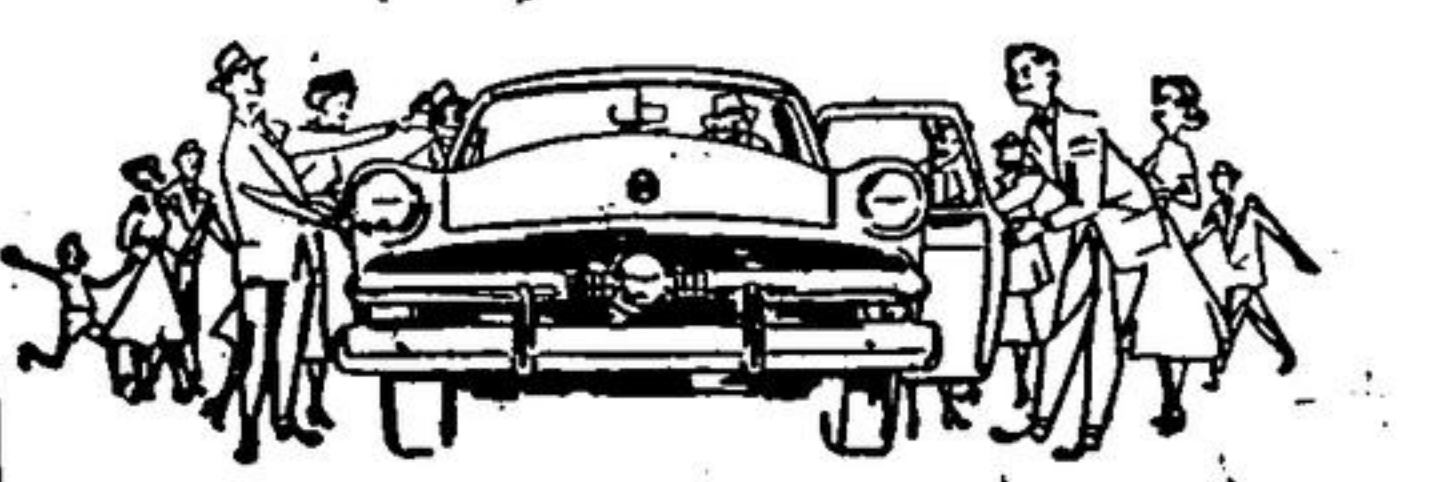
